Discussion took place regarding the 2022/23 allocated \$46,000 in Charter Fund Flexible dollars. CMS was required to spend \$30,000 in a Campus Security Associate. That person is in the hiring pipeline. CSA is not an officer, but can assist with supervision, monitoring of the building and reviewing camera footage. Schools will also determine how to use an additional \$15,000 for safety and security by the end of the 1st semester.
