Student success schools – 95% of students feel safe (physically and emotionally) -last year's data – 94% felt physically secure. 9% of students report feeling depressed more than? days per week.

Morrissey discussed partnership with Summit Counseling Center.

Students and staff culture – response percentage low – 13% of parents responded. 48% of families would recommend CMS.

67.2% of staff would recommend based on culture

Community and collaboration – Dr. Morrissey will be encouraging more community members (PTA) to attend SGC meetings.

Last agenda item -moved to next month -ideas to support Strategic Plan – steps to improve identified areas.
