Review of the Strategic Plan

Student Achievement:

3rd Grade Literacy – 87% students should be reading at or above grade level by the end of 3rd grade Focused on Balanced Literacy and providing training for teachers in the classroom. Making a college and career readiness connection through Project Based Learning.

People and Culture:

We survey parents and students and find out what they are most excited about. We currently have a 4-star climate rating and we want 5.

We are trying to retain high performing teachers beyond their 5th year. We are responding to this by developing teacher leadership and providing pathways for them to reach the next level. We are also focused on vertical alignment to provide seamless growth through K-12 education.

Reviewed the Strategic Plan Monitoring tool

We reviewed the challenges that the school is facing due to the disruption of extreme behaviors. We are continuing to build community collaboration and build on developing business partnerships.
