Reviewed End of Year Survey Results

- 88% would refer a staff member to join the council (work to boost this)
- Reviewed results for each question with the council
- Council keeps stake holders well informed of council work 5 voted always, 3 voted often (something we can pay attention to)
- Discussion from Principal Goggins about ways we communicate with parents (Dojo, Email, extra messages)
 - Weekly student of the week on Dojo to help get parents more involved
 - Working on ways to engage parents on ClassDojo so they are reading more messages
 - <u>Idea suggested:</u> Parent of the Week student shares a good story of something their parent did that was helpful (*Mr. Clark shared input about being careful with this because of different types of households*) Could we call it Caregiver of the Week?
- Mostly everyone is feeling that we are doing the work that we should be doing

Review the Budget Proposal

- \$44,500 Charter Dollars received this year (proposal numbers broken down)
 - \$7,000 MyOn Online Library
 - \$8,000 Face Fluency Kit
 - \$9,500 Teacher Supplies
 - \$5,000 In House STEM trip
 - \$15,000 Marquee
- Funding for marquee was asked about unable to get extra funding. Principal Goggins is going to reach out and ask for smaller amounts in hopes we get some contribution
- Marquee: Work to get business partners to donate and provide sponsorship
- Classroom Libraries: Tracy Braswell shared they would love to donate books. Principal Goggins shared we will accept any books they would love to donate.

- <u>Idea shared:</u> Teachers are doing a lot, lack of substitutes, any plans to support teachers for professional development or mental health break? Teachers need to be acknowledged and supported.
 - Unable to use Charter Dollars for teacher appreciation
 - Only allowed to spend \$5 per child for staff appreciation each year
 - Ivy met with PTO to discuss ways we can take care of the teachers (Luncheons/mailbox treats)
 - Jan shared best way to address teacher support would be to leverage the PTO. Something we do need to think about conversation Jan plans to have with her department
 - Parents ready to do what they need to do to raise funding from corporate partners to help support teachers.
- Budget was approved by the council

Capital Plan: 1 penny sales tax in existence, we are proposing that we continue the 1 penny sales tax to pay for school improvements. Plan to extend for another 5 years.

- Video shared about the Capital Plan and ESPLOST
- Our school upgrades: HVAC, Flooring, New roof, New devices
- Last SPLOST: brand new cameras
- We will have the opportunity to vote for this proposal
- Parents: proposal to build a new north springs high school

Principals Report

- Almost fully staffed, still have 2 para position we are working to staff. 1 is pending, and the other we are working to find a replacement.
- Covid: Strategies are in place. Sandy Springs and Roswell have been relatively low. Fewer than 20 cases this year so far

Any school related questions?

- School year ending. Any talk about after thanksgiving things ending early?
 We haven't heard anything but working to get devices in hands just in case. Working to get devices in hands of lower grades.
- Will the school promote any type of vaccination effort? Mobile vaccination?
 No answer for this, decisions that would be made at the district level and we would support from direction of central office.

- Having council drive fundraising efforts to raise money for marquee
- Reaching out to parents who may want to contribute
- Communications committee: work on verbiage/flyers
- Budget committee: think about how to best to do this. Collect pennies?
