- 2. Big Rock #1: Relationship Building- Parent, Student, and Staff
- 3. Positive Behavior School- incentives and rewards for students that make good choices or show improvement
- 4. Big Rock #2: Tier 1 Instruction
- 5. Ms. Brodkin- Just a point to make sure that we are not using these funds to buy supplies that can be crowd sourced
- Mr. Zink- at a previous school, they gave teachers individual funds and have a committee to approve grants for larger purchases or things for grade levels, etc. Wondering if PTO can support the school with supplies. \$7,000 for a field trip
- 7. Ms. Brodkin- are we fully utilizing volunteers/classroom parents? Worries that folks wouldn't show up.
- 8. Ms. Davis- How do we communicate to parents what is needed? Parents will give if they know what is needed.
- 9. Big Rock #3: Interventions for At-risk Students.
- 10. Bus Driver Shortage means no face-to-face afterschool, so we are contracting with a virtual company. This cost is being covered by the District.
- 11. Ms. O'hare- wondering about the devices, there is a supply shortage, should be 1 to 1 2<sup>nd</sup> grade and up.
- 12. Cirriculum Night will go over how to log into online resources.
