REGISTRATION INFORMATION

- Classes fill up quickly. Online registration remains available until 24 hours prior to the start date of the class. Once our maximum enrollment for a class has been met, registration closes.
- There is a 3.49% NON-REFUNDABLE service fee applied to all online registrations.
- Plan to attend class unless otherwise notified. You will be contacted BY EMAIL only if a class is cancelled or the time/ date/location has changed.
- Registrations ARE NOT accepted at class.
- Some classes require material fees and are noted in the class descriptions in the brochure. Material fees are paid directly to the instructor at the first class.
- For class withdrawals/refunds, please contact Community Education with class concerns or refund requests. Since many classes need a minimum enrollment in order to be held, a refund is guaranteed only if we cancel a class or you drop or transfer from a class five or more business days before the class start date.
- You will be charged a \$10 cancellation fee if you cancel after the above noted timeframe. We do not issue CASH REFUNDS. Refunds are processed with a district check which may take up to 21 business days for processing or you are refunded back to your credit card. There are NO REFUNDS for special events or "mini" classes (those meeting two times or less).
- Weather Cancellations and Postponements: If the Walled Lake School District is closed due to adverse weather conditions, then all Community Education programs will also be closed for that day. Youth League information will be posted on the Community Education Youth League Hotline at 248.956.5007. All clients will be notified BY EMAIL of rescheduled classes on the next business day.
- AFTER-SCHOOL ADVENTURE classes can only be attended at the student's home school. Please make sure when you register, that you are choosing a class held at your child's school.

When mailing your registration, include the completed registration form (available on our website), and check or money order made payable to WLCSD. Youth Assistance is a non-profit organization that offers professional counseling services and conducts programs for youth and their families who live within the Walled Lake School District. Our mission is to strengthen youth and families through volunteer involvement. LAYA is one of 26 programs of the Oakland County Circuit Court-Family Division.



TEAM FORMATION GUIDELINES

School children attend - Teams are formed with children from the same school first. If there is no coach, or not enough kids from a school, those players will be combined with players from the closest school possible. In the 5-6 Grade House league, 6th graders are divided as evenly as possible for competitive parity; however, they will be placed with another player from their school.

Balance of total team numbers - We strive to keep the total team numbers as close to even as possible across each league. Although 8-10 players on a team is optimal for the various leagues, teams can have up to 12-14 players on a team. In this case, games will have additional play time added to allow each player court time. With leagues that include three or more grades, we strive to have parity among teams with the oldest grade players.

****If a player is unable to attend a certain practice night (chosen by the volunteer coach), we will attempt to move the player to another night if team numbers allow. At minimum, we will add the player to the waitlist to see if further openings develop. If nothing becomes available, a refund will be processed (minus the \$10 drop fee).****

Availability of a volunteer coach - Volunteer coaches are a vital part of our program. There are seasons where we have more teams than coaches. If this occurs and we have two or more volunteers at the same school, we may split a school to have coaches for all teams. This would only occur when there are a sufficient number of players to keep the number of school teammates at three on each squad. In the event of a "no coach" team, we will look to parents to help. If there is no parent commitment, we may be forced to cancel the team and refund.

Late Registration - Players registering after the registration deadline has passed, will only be placed on a team if numbers permit.

Team Formation

Teams will be set up by the WLCE Recreation Dept. Players will be placed on teams using the Team Formation Guidelines. We are NOT able to honor special requests. Practices begin the week of June 16th for all teams (practice location/day - coach's choice). Players will be notified by their coach of practice times and location around June 13th. Each team will have at least one practice before their first game. Players will receive a jersey for participating. Register soon- spots fill up quickly!

Volunteer Coaching

All teams are lead by volunteer coaches. Mandatory background information, clearance and concussion training for volunteer coaches. If we do not have a coach for a team by the Coaches Clinic, that team will be cancelled, and registration will be refunded.

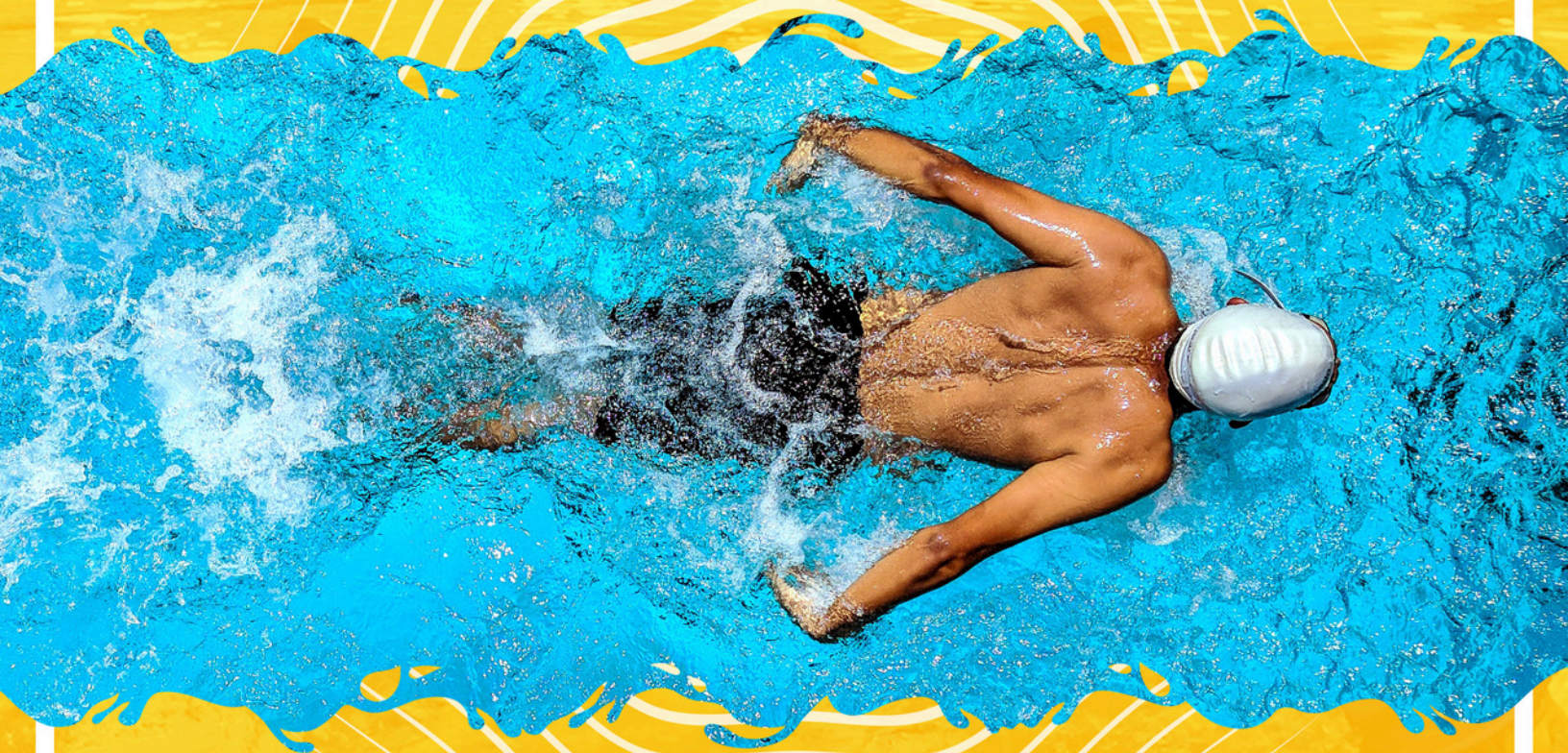

CERTIFIED BABYSITTER/CPR/FIRST AID



Learn to be safe and responsible. Build confidence! Have a competitive edge over other babysitters. Topics include first aid, when and how to call 911, CPR with manikin practice, choking, dealing with difficult behaviors, basic care methods like feeding and diapering, marketing and more!

Students will also learn how to be safe and responsible when home alone, including the importance of not giving out personal information and what to do if somebody comes to the door. Students who successfully complete the course requirements will receive a certificate of completion for Certified Babysitter/CPR/First Aid course by Live Safe Academy (valid for two years).

Please note that students must arrive on time to be certified, so please arrive up to 10 minutes early. To be certified students must participate in the entire course from beginning to end and successfully complete all skills, which requires full motor function of all four extremities.

Parents, this class is for students who are independent and responsible enough to be responsible for the safety and well-being of younger children without adult supervision. Class will end between 2 PM and 3 PM depending on when students complete the course requirements. Students need a lunch, snacks, and a fully charged cell phone (if they own one). If your student does not have a cell phone, please write down the cell phone number of the person picking them up and give it to the student. Students will message their ride at lunchtime to let their ride know what time to pick them up. Pen and paper for notes is optional. No cell phone use during class except during break. No refunds or credit with less than 24-hour notice. If you need a medical exception, email Live Safe Academy at info@LiveSafeAcademy.com before class. Please check in your student at the beginning of class. Drop off and pick up is in the same room as class. For more information please visit the Live Safe Website.
