

## NPHS CRITERIA FOR PLACEMENT

- Honors and Advanced Placement (AP) courses are available in English, mathematics, science, social studies, the fine arts and world languages. These courses offer enrichment in scope of material presented and in depth of exploration.
- Students who have the potential to succeed in honors or AP courses display a positive attitude and work ethic, the necessary aptitude, overall academic record, test results, previous achievement in the subject area, and teacher recommendation.
- Expectations: Students taking AP courses are expected to take the corresponding AP exams; payment for AP exams will be communicated from the school.

### ADVANCED PLACEMENT IN ENGLISH

<b><u>Placement into AP Language (11th grade) or AP Literature (12th grade)</u></b>
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All students must have at least **three** of the following criteria:

- All students must have a grade of at least a 90% in English 10 CP or at least and at least a 87% in English 10 Honors
- Teacher recommendation
- MAP ELA score of at least 80th percentile
- NJSLA score of a 4-5
- Minimum score of a 5 on AP writing sample.

### ADVANCED PLACEMENT IN MATHEMATICS

<b><u>Placement into Advanced Placement Calculus</u></b> <b>Prerequisite: Precalculus</b>	<b><u>Placement into Advanced Placement Statistics</u></b> <b>Prerequisite: Algebra 2</b>
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All students must have **three** of the following criteria:

- Grade of at least an 90% in Precalculus CP or 87% in Precalculus Honors
- Teacher recommendation
- MAP Math score of at least 80th percentile
- NJSLA score of a 4-5
- Minimum score of a 90% on midterm

All students must have **three** of the following criteria:

- Grade of at least a 90% in Algebra II CP or 87% in Algebra II Honors
- Teacher recommendation
- MAP Math score of at least 80th percentile
- NJSLA score of a 4-5
- Minimum score of a 90% on midterm
