School Year: 2021-2022



Overview of the Study

The Hewlett-Woodmere Public Schools School Quality Survey asked parents, campus-based staff members, and students in grades 6-12 for feedback on school climate. K12 *Insight* partnered with District team members to develop the surveys, which addressed the following topics:

- Academic Support
- Student Support
- School Leadership
- Family Involvement
- Safety and Behavior
- Communication (Parents and Staff Only)

The survey was open April 4 through 18 and re-opened May 6 through 20.

Email invitations with unique survey links were sent to parents, campus-based staff members, and secondary students (grades 6-12). Students could also access the survey using their student IDs in school. Parents with children attending more than one District school were able to take the survey again for each school.

This report summarizes survey results and breaks them down by participant group. Results are compared with those from 2019-2020 and 2020-2021.

Results do not reflect random sampling; therefore, they should not be generalized to all Hewlett-Woodmere Public Schools parents, campus-based staff members, and students in grades 6-12. Rather, results reflect only the perceptions and opinions of survey participants. School-level reports are provided separately.

Findings for each item in the report exclude participants who did not answer. In charts and graphs, data labels less than 5 percent are not shown. Percentages may not total 100 due to rounding.

Executive Summary

- Of all participant groups, campus-based staff (96%) had the highest percentage of excellent or good ratings for the overall quality of their school, which remains unchanged from last school year.
 - 93% of parents rated the overall quality of their child's school as excellent or good, a 2 percentage point decrease from last year.
 - 81% of students rated the overall quality of their school as excellent or good, a 6 percentage point increase from last year. It is important to note that 30% of students ranked their school as excellent, an 8 percentage point increase from last year.
- Perception gaps exist between stakeholder groups within the dimension of Academic Support. For example, 47% of participating students responded favorably (Strongly Agree or Agree) that teachers successfully show students how lessons relate to life outside of school compared to 62% of parents and 85% of campus-based staff members. Compared to last year, the percentage of favorable responses from parents decreased by 5 percentage points (67%), but for students it increased 8 percentage points (39%), and campus-based staff members it increased by 6 percentage points (79%).
- Within the dimension of Student Support, participating students were more likely to strongly agree or agree that there is a staff member students can go to for help with a school problem (87%) compared to a personal problem (68%). This is consistent with last year's results.
- Within the dimension of Safety and Behavior, a perception gap emerged between participating stakeholder groups. For example, 57% of students and 60% of parents strongly agreed or agreed that staff members are responsive to bullying whereas 91% of campus-based staff said the same. Additionally, 71% of students and 74% of parents said bullying is not tolerated compared to 91% of campus-based staff.








Overall Quality: Comparison by Respondent Type

How would you rate the overall quality of your/ your child's school?




Dimension Scores: Comparison by Respondent Type









Safety and Behavior: Comparison by Respondent Type







Perceptions of Unfair Treatment: Comparison by Respondent Type



How likely are you to recommend your child's school to a friend or colleague? (N=435)



How likely are you to recommend your school to a friend or colleague? (N=305)



How likely are you to recommend your school to a friend or colleague? (N=642)



How likely are you to recommend Hewlett-Woodmere Public Schools to a friend or colleague? (N=433)



How likely are you to recommend Hewlett-Woodmere Public Schools to a friend or colleague? (N=310)



How likely are you to recommend Hewlett-Woodmere Public Schools to a friend or colleague? (N=643)








School Leadership: Comparison Over Time






Family Involvement: Comparison Over Time


















Dimension Scores: Comparison Over Time






Academic Support: Comparison Over Time








Student Support: Comparison Over Time










How likely are you to recommend your school to a friend or colleague?








Dimension Scores: Comparison Over Time


















How likely are you to recommend your school to a friend or colleague?










Participation by Gender
