Scarborough Public Schools will launch a public Pre-K pilot program in the fall of 2024, to include one classroom of 16 students. We seek to serve children from each of our three neighborhood districts: Blue Point, Eight Corners, and Pleasant Hill. We are extremely fortunate to be partnering with The Shooting Stars Program, located at 152 Rt. 1 in Scarborough. Shooting Stars is a high quality program which has been serving



preschoolers for the last 20 years.

NEW CDC Recommendations



NEW CDC Recommendations For Return Following Respiratory Illnesses Including COVID-19

The recommendations, as of March 1, 2024, suggest returning to normal activities when, for at least 24 hours:

- symptoms are improving overall
- if a fever was present, it has been gone without use of a fever-

reducing medication (ie: Ibuprofen/Motrin or Acetaminophen/Tylenol)

Upon return to school/activities it is recommended that you do the following for the next 5 days:

- Continue to practice good hand hygiene
- Wear a well fitted mask
