Procedure for a Remote Learning Day (Flexible Instruction Day): The superintendent will decide when to implement this option and will notify parents and teachers via the usual methods (mass communication call, website, social media, etc.)

Grade Level	What do you do for the day?	How do I take attendance?	What if I need to ask a teacher a question?
K-4	Depending on the technology available at home you may either complete one of the following based on how you answered the survey conducted earlier this year or how the building principal and their staff has decided to provide education: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Print packet • Online learning using Google Classroom or similar platform 	Evidence of work completed for your assignments will count as your attendance.	If using a print packet, there should be an email listed. Keep in mind, if your teacher is absent on this day, they may get back to you when they return to work. If you're using Google Classroom, contact them using the directed method on Google Classroom or using their district email.
Middle School (5-8)	Online learning using Canvas. Look for assignments on Canvas as you normally would, paying close attention to the dates of the assignment(s).	Evidence of work completed for your assignments will count as your attendance.	Send the teacher a message on Canvas. Keep in mind, if your teacher is absent on this day, they may get back to you when they return to work.
High School (9-12)	Online learning using Canvas. Look for assignments on Canvas as you normally would, paying close attention to the dates of the assignment(s).	Evidence of work completed for your assignments will count as your attendance.	Send the teacher a message on Canvas. Keep in mind, if your teacher is absent on this day, they may get back to you when they return to work.

Further information:

- Online learning will occur between **10:00am and 2:30pm**. This is the time frame teachers will be available online.
- If you don't complete the assignment during the Remote Learning Day (internet issues, computer hardware issues, etc.), then you have 5 school days to make it up. If you miss the assignment completely, you'll receive a zero and will need to have your parent send an excuse in for the Remote Learning Day date or receive an unexcused absence.
