BAYSIDE COMMUNITY DAY SCHOOL

Bayside Community Day School is an alternative education program for students in grades 9 through 12. Targeted enrollees are students who are identified as at-risk due to attendance affecting their behavior, or academic standing.

PROGRAM OPPORTUNITIES:

- Family-friendly environment for grades 11-12 (16 years+)
- Credit recovery opportunities
- Small class sizes, no more than 24 students per class
- Students earn credits each day they are in attendance at school
- Opportunity for online credit recovery
- Career Technical Education (CTE) program course in Retail Sales and Marketing and Construction
- Computer Information System class
- Construction class
- Opportunity for college visits, and career information
- Work experience opportunities
- Experienced counselor to help guide students to post-high school options
- Sports offered – volleyball, soccer, and basketball



MARCH MOUNTAIN HIGH SCHOOL

March Mountain High School is a continuation high school that houses a variety of programs specifically designed for students whose needs have not been met at comprehensive high schools.

PROGRAM OPPORTUNITIES:

- For students in grades 11-12 (16 years+)
- A-G approved courses
- Credit recovery opportunities (up to 75 per year)
- Online credit recovery class
- 22 students per class
- Emphasis on academic, social, and emotional growth
- Support for students with lack of motivation, lack of academic progress, credit deficiency, and/or smaller learning environment
- Electives offered – Art, ASB, accounting, child development, computer, peer leadership, psychology, and Spanish
- Sports offered – softball, volleyball, basketball, and soccer
- University/college field trips
- Work experience course
- Senior trip and "Grad Nite"
- Bible Club
