- 1. \$ 80,000 for outdoor improvements including baseball field, cross country trail, and playground
- 2. \$ 30,000 to provide summer school for the next 3 years
- 3. \$ 90,000 for technology and software improvements including digital curriculum
- 4. \$ 60,000 for sanitation and ventilation improvements including window replacements and a new commercial dishwasher.
- 5. \$ 215,379 for salaries, stipends, and contracted services to address learning losses due to the impact of Covid 19.
