Minutes:

- The council took a motion to approve the minutes from the 4.23.23 SHAC meeting
 - Motion to approve: Andrew Clemens

 - The motion passed unanimously
- Senate Bill 629: Opioid Antagonists were discussed by the council
 - Narcan Units on every LDISD Campus including DAEP
 - Units will be on specific personnel
 - Nurse, Principal, Assistant Principal, SRO, Athletic Trainer
 - Units will be in specific locations
 - Each office of the staff mentioned above, the Athletic Trainer's "go bag" and mobile unit, each AED box in the district
 - All the above staff members will be trained annually in signs symptoms of opioid abuse and how to administer Narcan in an emergency
 - The Narcan units will be maintained, disposed of, and replaced on the same routine schedule that the AED boxes are monitored
- The council took a motion to recommend and approve the procedures and best practices set by the district to meet the requirements of Senate Bill 629.
 - Motion to approve: Courtney Martin
 - 2nd: Angie Wren
 - The motion passed unanimously
- The council discussed a 5th grade Human Growth and Development program: Proctor & Gambell "Always Changing Puberty Education Program"
 - Opt In program only for students
 - Notice and consent goes to parents 2 weeks prior to program
 - Boys & Girls take part in the program separately and will only discuss gender specific information
 - Video is shown to students, and then students are able to write down any questions they have for a staff member to answer or address
