COVID-19 UPDATES & REMINDERS

Posted March 4, 2021 at 11am by HEBISD:

Following the Governor's change to his statewide mask mandate, the Texas Education Agency issued updated guidance for school districts. This update allows schools to maintain the same mask COVID-19 safety protocols in place prior to the Governor's announcement. Tarrant County Public Health, Texas Department of State Health Services, and the Centers for Disease Control & Prevention continue to recommend the use of face coverings as part of a set of precautions to help prevent the spread of COVID-19. HEB ISD has made the decision to continue to follow our Return to Learn Plan, including rules pertaining to face coverings. We will continue to review our Return to Learn Plan and make any necessary changes based on guidance from public health authorities prior to the start of the 2021-2022 school year.

- If your student is awaiting a COVID 19 test or test results, please do not send your student to school until you receive the test results.
- If someone in your household is awaiting test results, please do not send your student to school.
- If your student has a fever, chills, cough, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, muscle or body aches, unusual headache, diarrhea, nausea or vomiting, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell, congestion, or a runny nose please do not send your student to school.
- If your Euless Junior High student or another school-aged student in the household is on quarantine, please do not send your student to school.
- If your student is a virtual student, that comes to campus for athletics and is on quarantine, please do not send your student to school.

Not following these protocols affects many students and families who are doing their best to keep those around them healthy. Please do your part to help us keep students in school.


