
### **COVID-19 UPDATES & REMINDERS**

# BLACKOUT POETRY WITH MRS. CREWS









Blackout poetry is a form of found poetry and it is a great opportunity for students to be really creative while creating something new out of something that already exists.

Some creators of blackout poetry even choose to utilize color and design to produce visual works of art.








