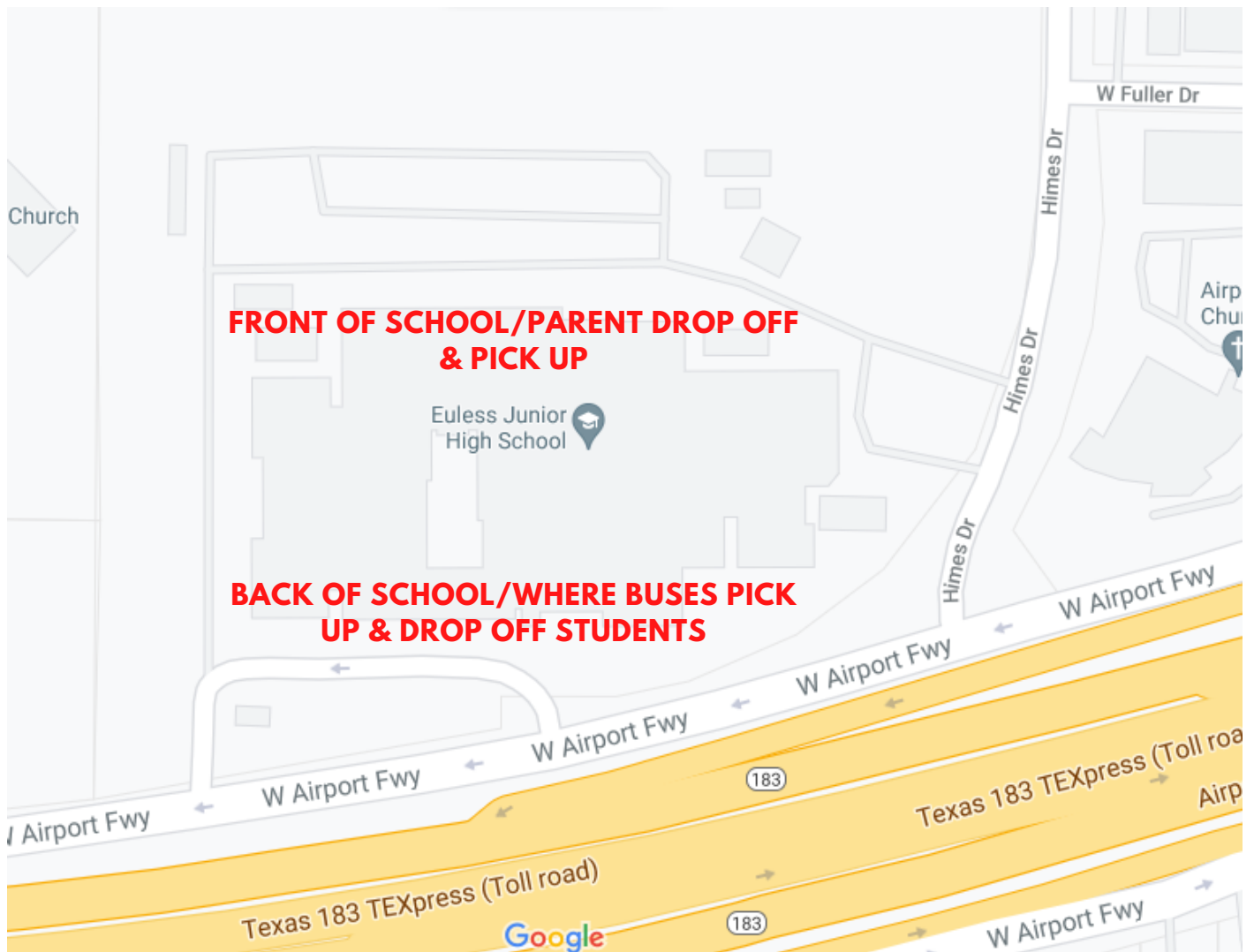
WELCOME TO THE NEW SCHOOL YEAR, STALLIONS!

The first day of school is Wednesday, Aug. 11th! Doors open at 7:45 a.m. for students that are dropped off early. Students can either go to the cafeteria to eat breakfast, the library, the courtyard, or the main hallway until the first period bell rings at 8:20 am. 7th period ends at 3:35 pm and from there students will either go to the front of the school (North side of building) if they are being picked up or walking, or to the back of the school (South side of building, by the access road) to be picked up by their school bus.

Morning arrival/drop off is located at the front of the building (North side), and all students who are not bus riders will enter through the front doors.

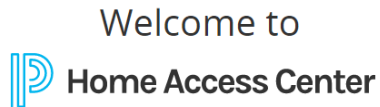
SCHOOL SUPPLIES

Please do not worry if your child was not able to attend New Stallion Night or get their schedule yet.

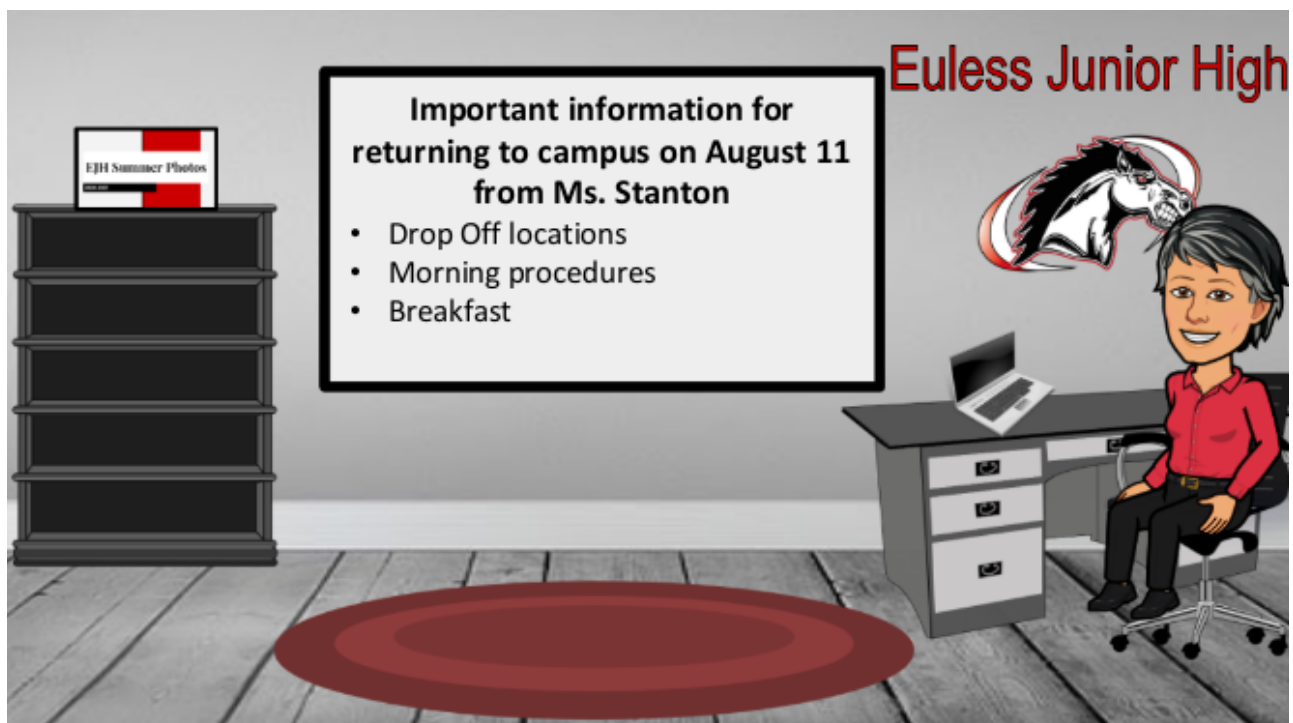
