



# VIEW YOUR CHILD'S COURSE CONTENT

Most of you already know that you can check your child's grades and attendance in Home Access Center (HAC), but did you know that parents can sign up as an observer in Canvas? Observers can link their Canvas account to their student's account so they can see assignment dues dates, announcements, and other course content. Observers can view the course content but cannot participate in the course.

Something that I recently included on the last page is a link to get insurance coverage for your student's device. We all know that stuff happens and sometimes replacing or repairing a device can be expensive.
