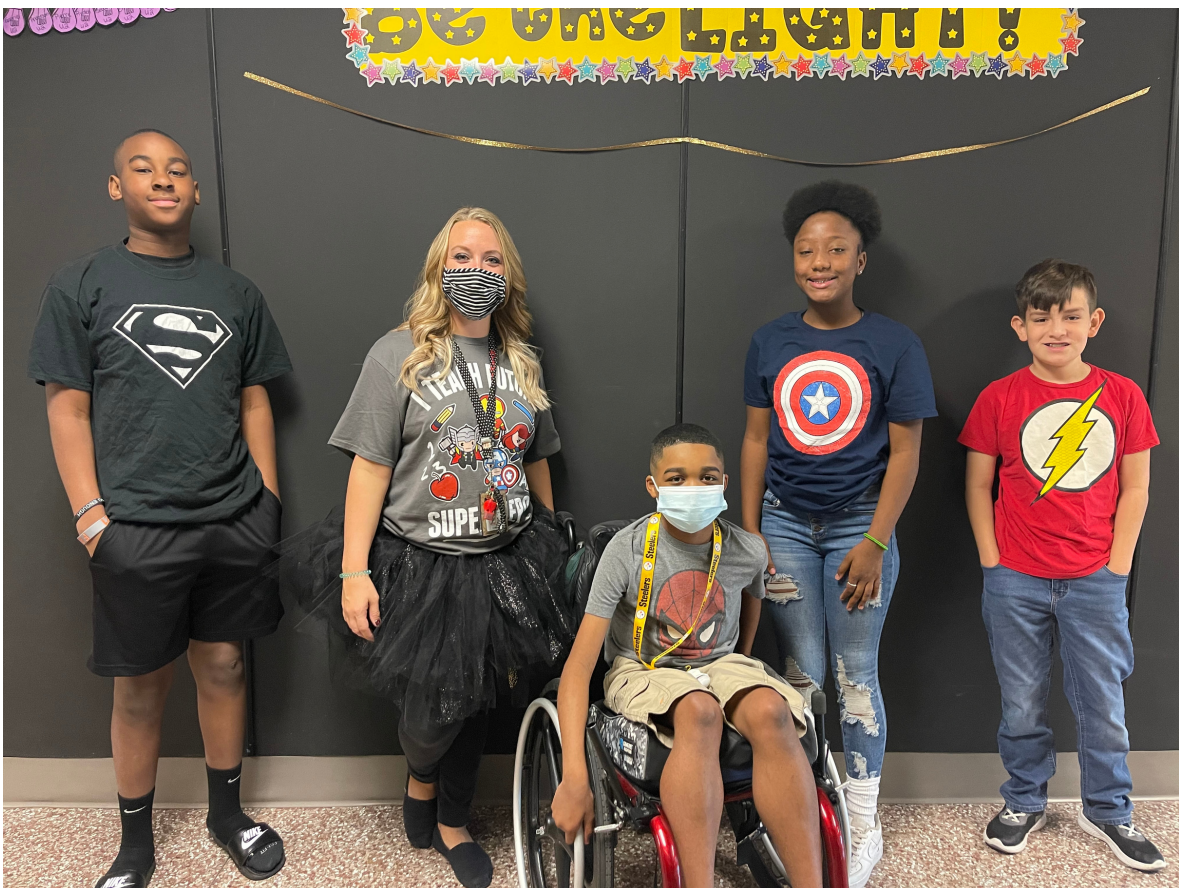

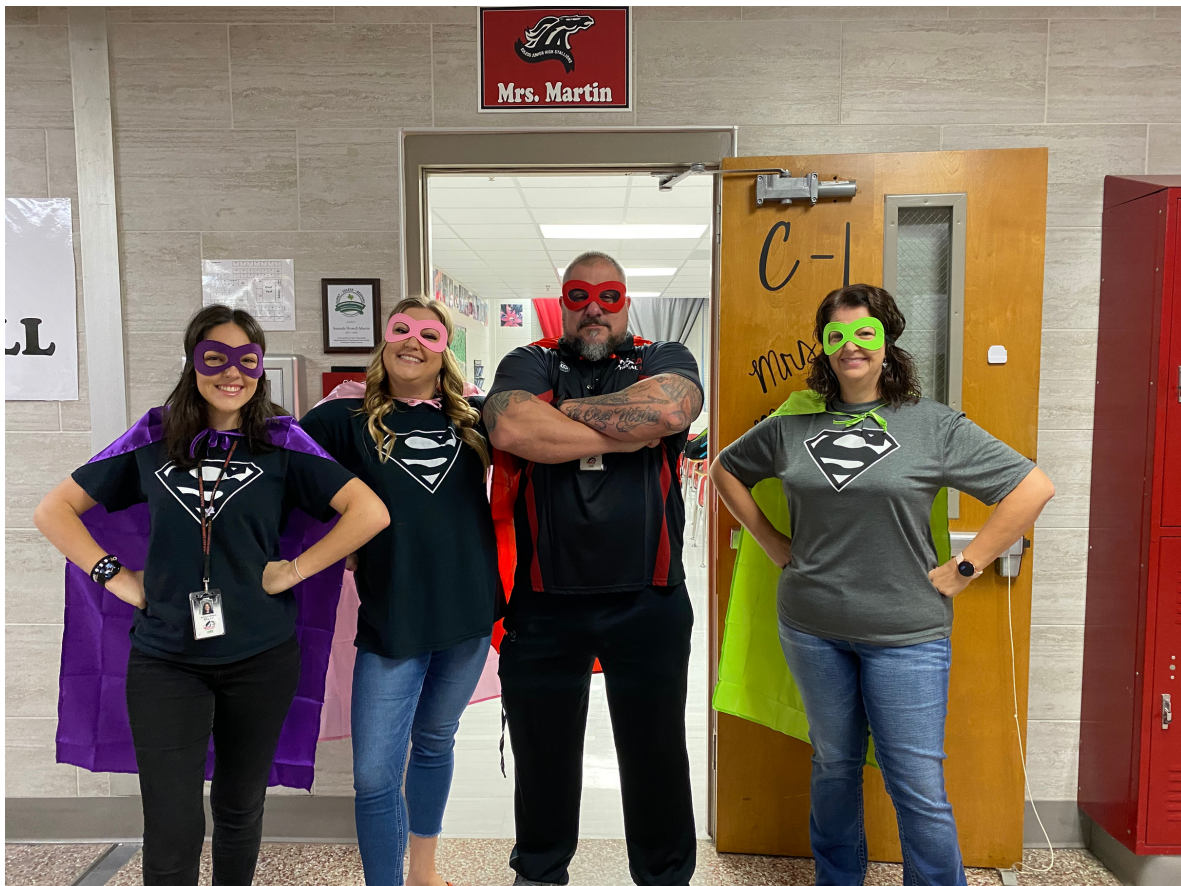

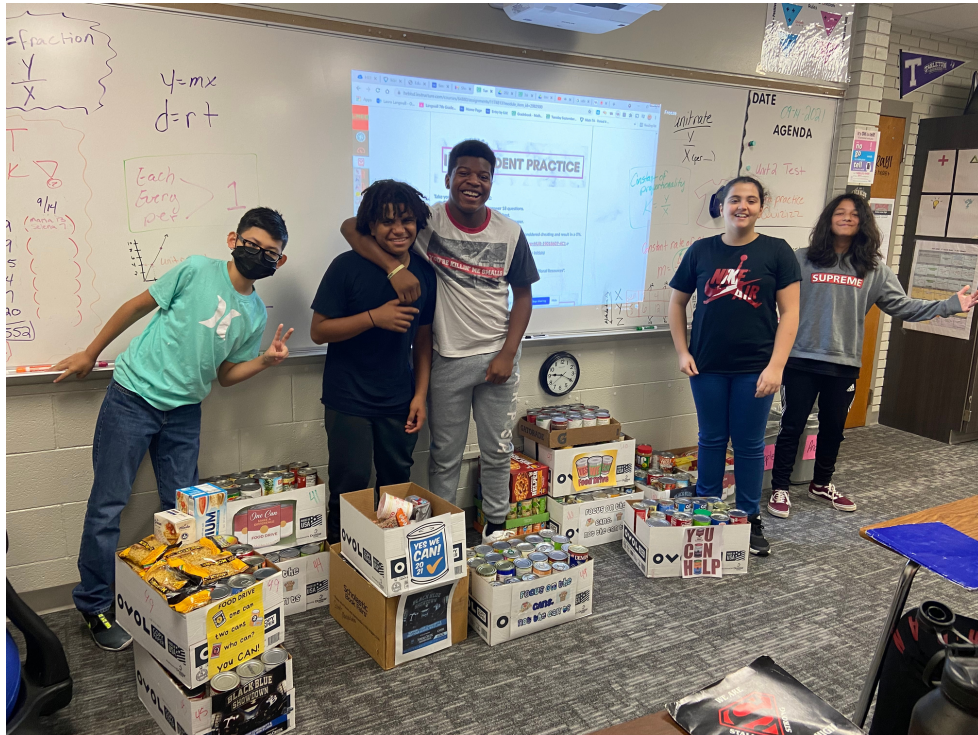

On Wednesday, September 29th, the EJH band will perform in the stands for the 9th grade football game.





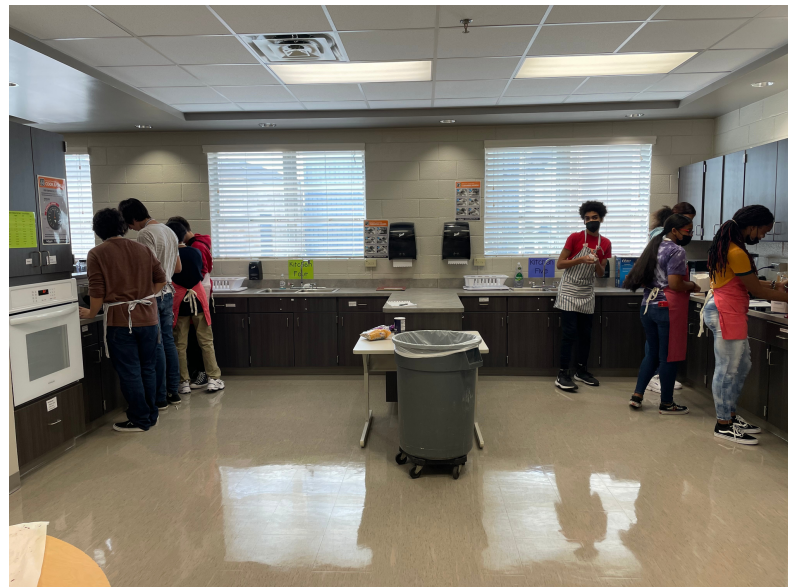
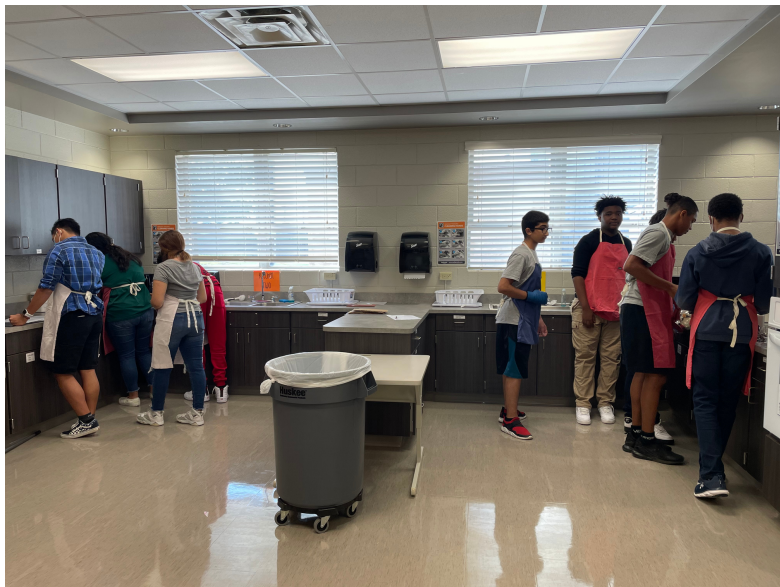
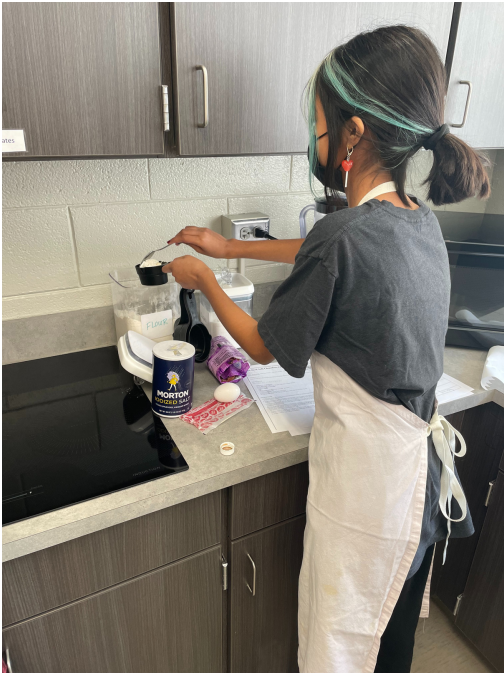
# THANK YOU FOR SHOWING UP EVERYDAY

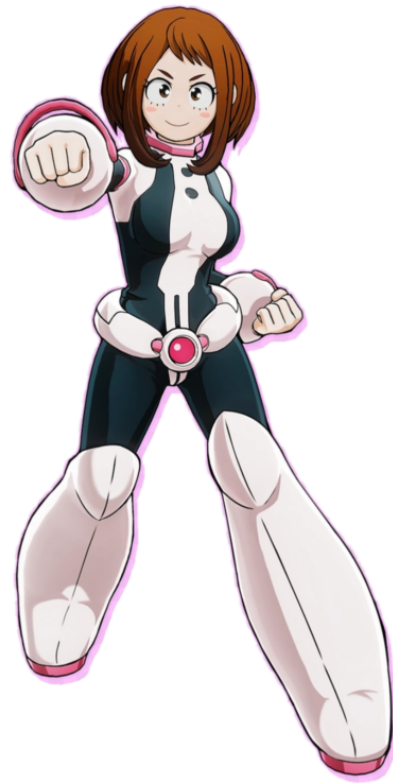
