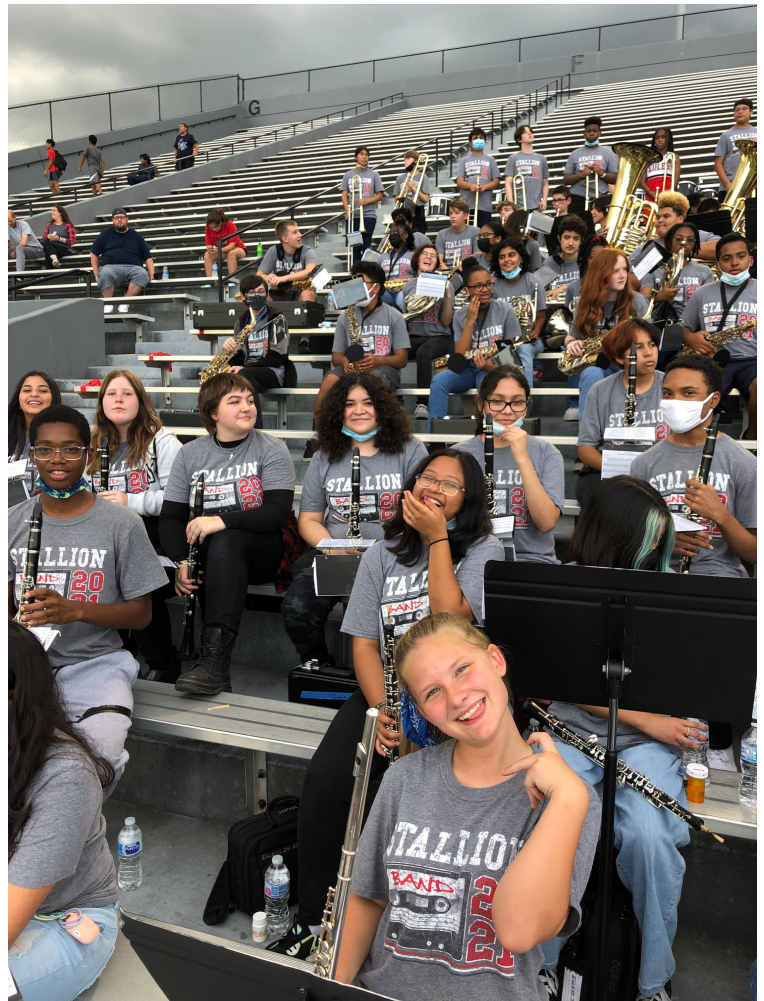

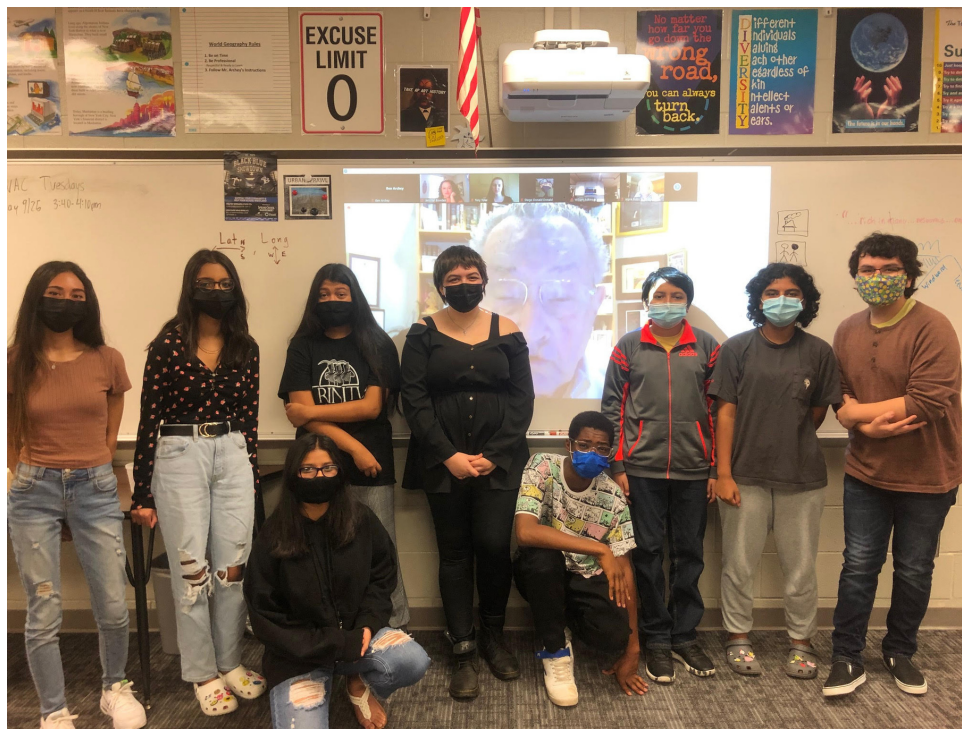

EULESS JUNIOR WORLD AFFAIRS COUNCIL MEET

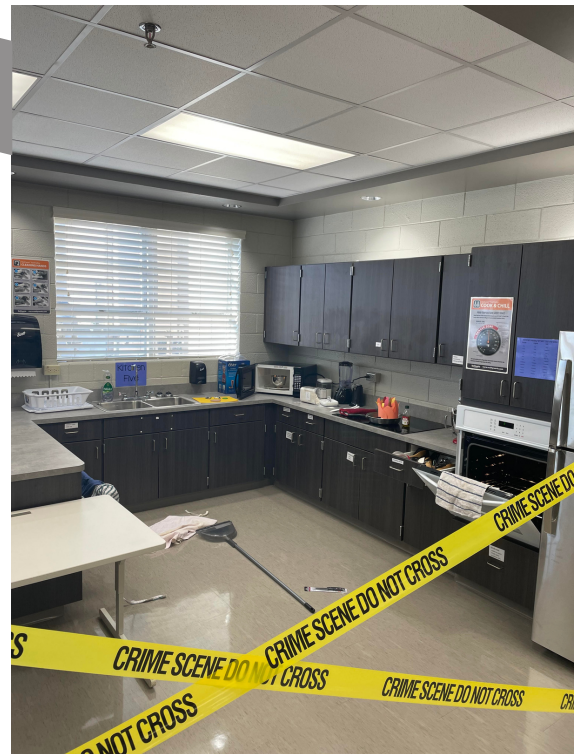
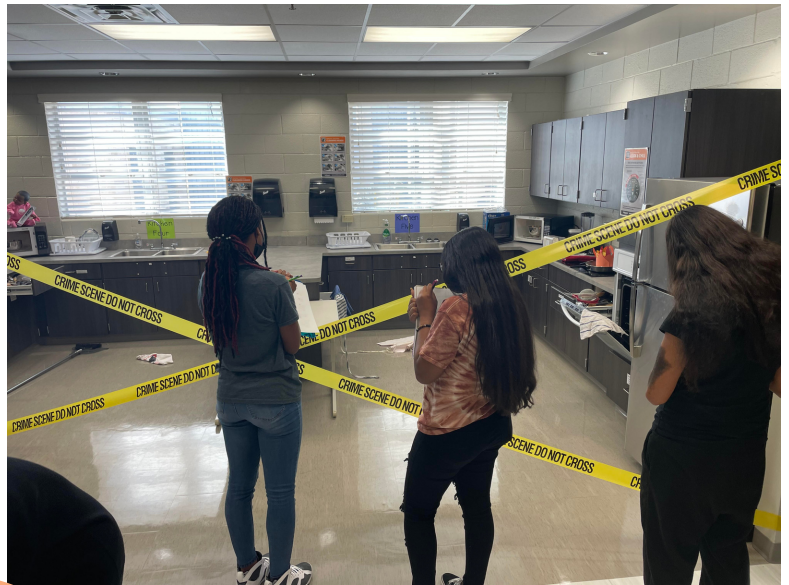
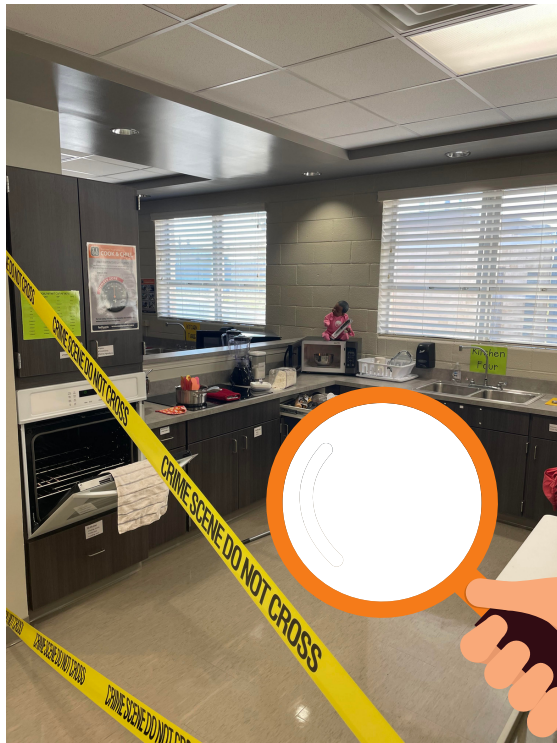
