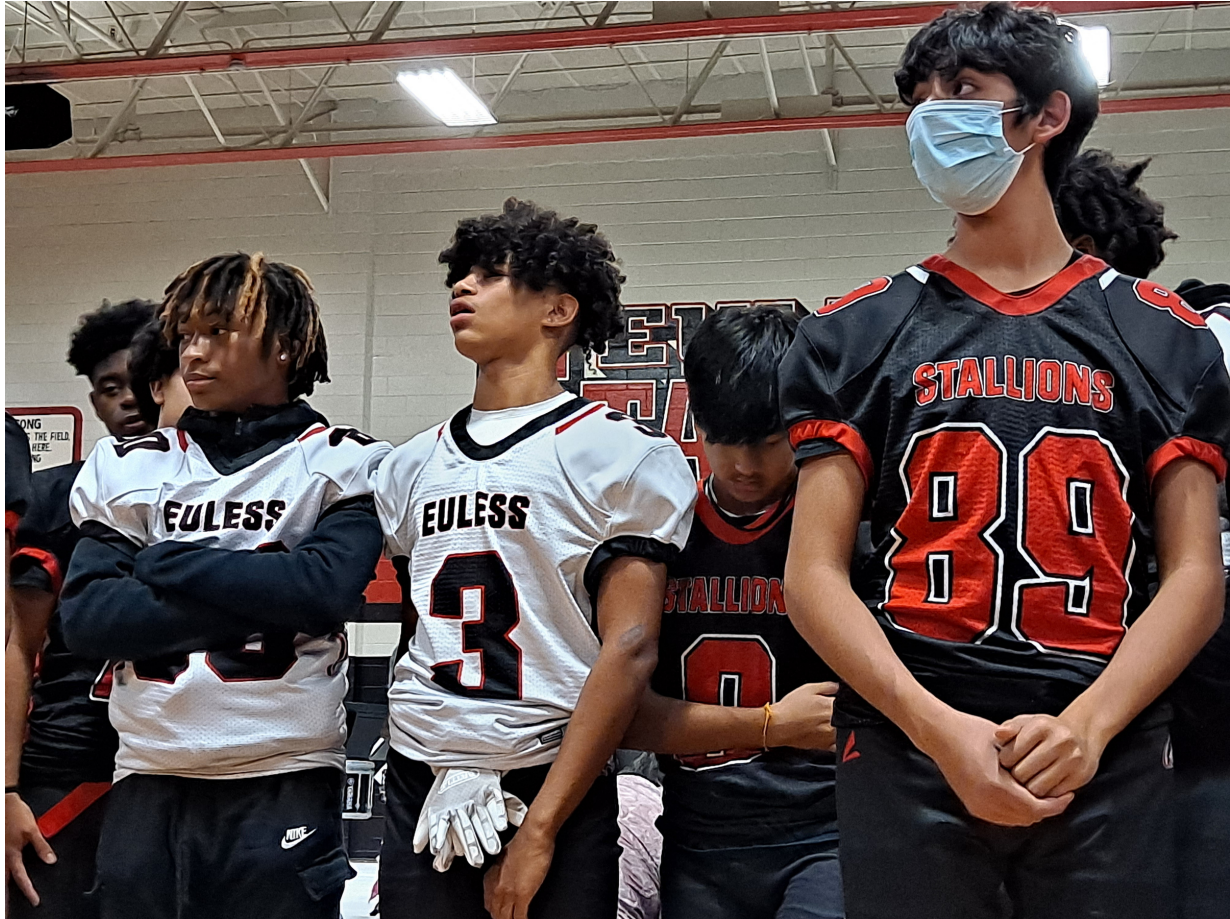

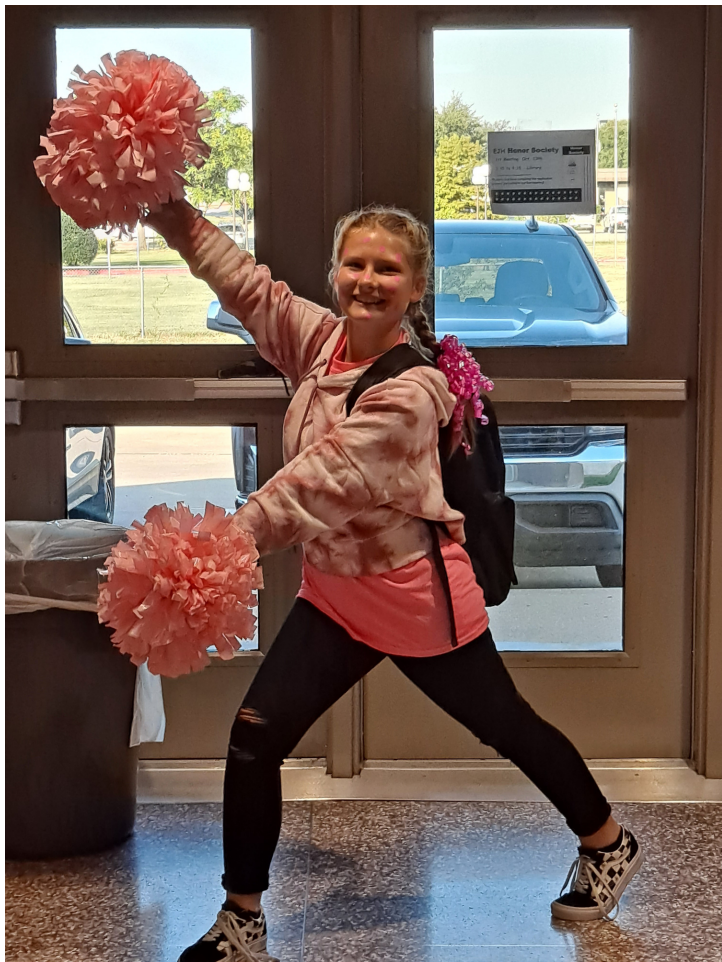
STALLIONS SHOW TRUE STRENGTH ON PINK OUT DAY

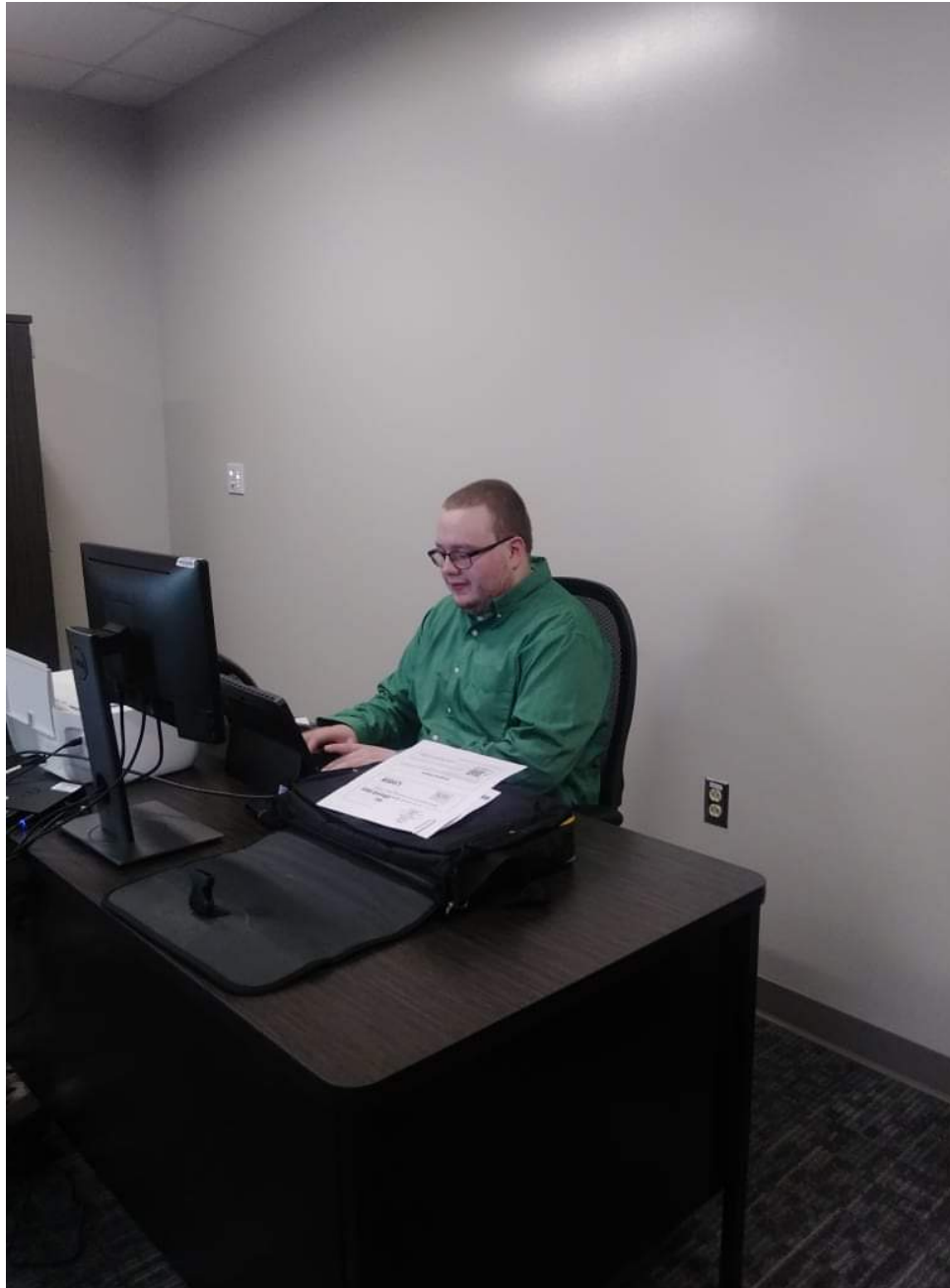
