Congratulations to our March Students of the Month!



TRIO Talent Search students created their Dream College folders by cutting out pictures and words from college brochures. The students had fun being creative with this lesson.









WHAT IS IMPOSSIBLE?

Your child is scheduled to take the upcoming STAAR/EOC Assessment appropriate for his/her grade level for the 2021-22 academic year.

Algebra 1	8th or 9th Grade	May 11
Science	8th Grade	May 12
Biology 1	9th Grade	May 12
US History	11th Grade	May 12
Social Studies	8th Grade	May 13
Math	3rd - 8th Grade	May 17
Reading	3rd - 8th Grade	May 18
Science	5th Grade	May 19

House Bill 4545 requires students who do not pass STAAR/EOC assessments to complete thirty (30) hours of academic support in that content area. For most students, these hours of academic support are completed through our summer programs. Students in grade 6 will receive their academic support through placement in a STAAR class in grade 7.

*Please note that if a student does not take an assessment he/she cannot demonstrate appropriate grade-level performance and will have to complete the 30 hours. Academic support for House Bill 4545 will be offered:

Grades 3-5 Math or Reading	June 6-24
Grade 5 Science	Next school-year
Grade 6-8 Math or Reading	Next school-year as an additional course
Grade 8 Science or Social Studies	June 13-24 or June 27-July 8
Any EOC content	June 6-17 with EOC retesting June 21-24

Parent(s)/Guardian(s) will receive notification of required summer programming by May 26, 2022.

Summer acceleration will be offered at the following campuses:

3rd - 5th Grade STAAR:	Arbor Creek, Bell Manor, Stonegate, and Trinity Lakes
7th - 8th Grade STAAR:	Central JH
9th - 11th Grade EOC:	L.D. Bell HS

The H.E.B. Teen Court is looking for adult and teen volunteers. Volunteering for Teen Court is a great way to serve your community. The minimum age for teen volunteers is 13. Teens and adults work together to provide defendants the opportunity to take responsibility for their actions, while learning about the justice system. Teen volunteers learn public speaking skills, interviewing techniques and administrative skills. Local attorneys and the Teen Court Coordinator combine their time and talents to provide all teen volunteers with thorough training. Teen Court is a peer program that allows juvenile first offenders with Class C misdemeanors an alternative in the criminal justice system. Teen volunteers serve as the attorneys, bailiffs and clerks, while adult volunteers assist during court sessions as jury monitors and judges.
