
GETTING TO & FROM SCHOOL

Doors open at 7:45. Students will need to report to the cafeteria, tutoring, or the library until 8:00. At 8 AM students will be released from the cafeteria to report to their 1st period class. 1st period starts at 8:20. 7th period ends at 3:35 pm. Students being picked up by a parent/guardian or walking home will exit the front (north side) of the building. Students riding a bus will exit the back (highway side) of the building to load the buses. When they are running on time, buses leave at 3:45. Please understand our buses deliver elementary students first and will run late after school during the first week of school and occasionally throughout the school year.

Morning arrival/drop off is located at the front of the building (North side), and all students who are not bus riders will enter through the front doors.

Students will not be able to wait for a ride next door at Airport Freeway Church of Christ. If students are waiting on a ride, then they need to remain on campus.

SCHEDULE CHANGES

SCHOOL SUPPLIES

There is no official school supply list for junior high. What we are recommending is that each student comes with something to write with and something to write on for the first day, like a notebook and a pencil. They will receive their device on the first day and also learn more from each of their teachers about what supplies they are going to need for each class.

Free school supplies were offered through 6 Stones in their Operation Back 2 School program this year and we have not received any extra boxes. If there is a need for school supplies please reach out to our Communities in Schools social worker Mrs. Haggard.

EULESS JUNIOR HIGH FOLDERS

All students receive a Euless Junior High folder with important expectations and policies. Parents and students are able to refer to this as well as **HEB ISD'S Student Handbook and Code of Conduct 2022-2023**.

HEALTH CARE THINGS TO KNOW

MEDICATION

- All medication (prescription and non-prescription) given at school requires a Request for Administration of Medication signed by a parent and physician. Information to be included is student's name, name of medication, dosage, time and route of administration. Form may be downloaded and printed from the **EJH Nurse website**.
- All medication must be in a properly labeled prescription container. Non-prescription medication must be in an original container.
- Temporary prescription medications (to be given at school for less than 10 days) may be given with a parent signed Request to Administer medication and the medication in a labeled medication bottle or discharge instructions from the prescribing physician.
- Inhalers and Epinephrine delivery systems may be carried by the student, especially in athletics, but documentation as described above is required.
- Students MAY NOT bring medication to school for self administration. ALL medication is to be brought to the EJH Clinic with appropriate documentation to be administered by the nurse. No medication will be returned to a student. This includes OTC medication and cough drops.

IMMUNIZATIONS

All students entering 7th grade have two additional immunizations required that were not required in elementary school. A Tetanus/pertussis immunization within the past 5 years and a Meningococcal vaccine.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Students should not call or text parents to pick them up for illness. The procedure is to go through the clinic for evaluation. Parents will then be called when necessary.

**Progress Reports are sent home in English, Science, Math, History, and Reading. Report Cards will no longer be sent home. Check your student's grades on Home Access Center*

** According to HEB district policy, 7th and 8th grade students will be required to pass English, math, science, and social studies to be promoted to the next grade. Failure to meet approaches grade level standards on the STAAR test may be grounds for retention in grades 7 and 8.*

** 9th grade students must earn 5 credits before advancing to 10th grade.*

Home Access Center

The Home Access Center provides parents with a convenient way to monitor student data online. The HAC is a "one-stop" portal to view your student's schedule, grades, and some other data through a secure web interface.

Report Cards

HEB will no longer print report cards. In order to view your student's report card you will need to log into Home Access Center. Report Cards will be posted on: 9/23, 11/4, 1/6, 2/24, 4/14, & 6/2.

Tutoring

Teachers are available for tutoring every morning (7:45-8:05) and every afternoon (3:35-4:10) Course specific tutoring time and rooms are posted in the hallways, Stallion Stampede Parent Newsletter, and on teacher websites.

Retesting

Except for 6 weeks and semester tests, students may retake any major test they scored below a 70. The student must arrange a time with the teacher. The maximum grade for a test retaken is a 70.

Zero-Low Grade Make-up

In the 5th week of each 6 weeks, students will have an opportunity to make up a zero or low grade from the daily grade category with a "zero-low grade make-up assignment".

TARDY POLICY/LEAVING CLASS

Students should be either in the room when the bell rings or in their desks when the bell rings. The teacher has communicated which of these they expect from your student.

- On the 3rd and ensuing tardy to class during a six weeks, the student receives a Tardy Hall slip. Tardy Hall is every Friday from 3:45-4:45.
- If a student needs to leave class, on the 3rd and ensuing occasions during the 6 weeks, the student will receive a detention.
- Tardy and leave records clear every 6 weeks.
