



COMPUTER SCIENCE MAKER SPACE




Today (Friday, September 16) is National Teacher's Assistant Day!



EJH SPINAL SCREENING



We will begin 8th grade boys spinal screening the week of Sept 19, 2022 in the Nurse Clinic. Please let the nurse know if you have any questions or concerns. This is required by law however, if you do not wish you child to be screened, you are able to submit an affidavit of exemption to the school nurse. Also the results of a professional examination may be submitted in lieu of the required screening. If your child is under treatment for scoliosis, please notify the school nurse.

Dallas Care Van® Program

Free Immunizations

For eligible children

2 months thru 18 years of age

Child may be eligible for free immunizations from the Caring Foundation's Care Van if they meet one of the following criteria:

Child does NOT have health insurance

Child enrolled in Medicaid

Child's health insurance plan does not cover vaccines (underinsured)

An American Indian or Alaska Native

NOTE: All children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by parent or guardian.

Please bring child's complete immunization records - required for this free service.




