Congratulations to our September Students of the Month!



Thank you for providing us with an amazing example of what it means to be FabEuleless.




SEPTEMBER TEACHER OF THE MONTH


ROOKIE STALLION OF THE YEAR



CUSTODIAN APPRECIATION WEEK

We wore our superhero gear for our spirit day on Thursday to encourage our Freshman Stallion football team as they played the Central JH Spartans.










Mrs Martin's 8th grade science students reviewed for a test with the help of Liquid Chalk Markers and writing on lab tables. They are going to ace this test.




CANNED FOOD DRIVE PARTY

- Average to above average intelligence
- Reading failure is unexpected when compared to other abilities
- Mainly affects reading, writing, and spelling
- Can affect automatic recall of stored facts, math calculations, comprehension, processing speed, and working memory
- Often comes with talents in art, music, problem solving, designing, and creating
- 10-20% of any population with an alphabetic language lives with dyslexia

Free Immunizations

For eligible children

2 months thru 18 years of age

Child may be eligible for free immunizations from the Caring Foundation's Care Van if they meet one of the following criteria:

Child does NOT have health insurance

Child enrolled in Medicaid

Child's health insurance plan does not cover vaccines (underinsured)

An American Indian or Alaska Native

NOTE: All children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by parent or guardian.

Please bring child's complete immunization records - required for this free service.
