Thank you to Albertsons of Eules for donating cupcakes and Bailey Jean Designs for donating the balloon arch.





















BLACKOUT THE BLACKHAWKS

9th graders in Mrs. Lescoat's Biology class did a fermentation lab. Here they are collecting CO₂ and measuring amounts.





NATIONAL CHILD ID PROGRAM






They are both so close to their goals! Let's rally in these last few days to help these wonderful programs meet their goals.




LOG YOUR VOLUNTEER HOURS!

For eligible children

2 months thru 18 years of age

Child may be eligible for free immunizations from the Caring Foundation's Care Van if they meet one of the following criteria:

Child does NOT have health insurance

Child enrolled in Medicaid

Child's health insurance plan does not cover vaccines (underinsured)

An American Indian or Alaska Native

NOTE: All children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by parent or guardian.

Please bring child's complete immunization records - required for this free service.


