Dear Parents and families,

Cold/flu season is upon us. There is a rise of respiratory illnesses in Tarrant County and in school settings. The CDC has predicted higher than normal respiratory illnesses this year. We would like to encourage you to help decrease the spread of these illnesses by helping your children remember to wash hands often, cover their cough or sneeze, and keep your children home when they are sick.

At the school, we are encouraging handwashing, sharing videos about handwashing, wiping down high traffic surfaces often, face shields are available for the cafeteria, hand sanitizer is available around the building.

When to wash your hands:

- 1. Before and after eating or preparing food
- 2. After using the restroom
- 3. After recess/playing outside
- 4. After coughing or sneezing in your hands (try to cover with your elbow)
- 5. After blowing your nose
- 6. After touching animals
- 7. After touching garbage

How to wash your hands:

- 1. Wet your hands with clean, running water and apply soap.
- 2. Lather your hands by rubbing them together; lather the back of hands, between your fingers, and under your nails.
- 3. Scrub for at least 20 seconds; sing the ABC song or Happy Birthday twice!
- 4. Rinse your hands under clean running water.
- 5. Dry your hands using a clean paper towel or air dryer.

When to stay home from school:

- 1. Fever over 100.0 student needs to remain home until fever free without using fever reducing medication
- 2. Diarrhea no diarrhea for 24 hours before returning
- 3. Vomiting no vomiting for 24 hours before returning
- 4. Any communicable disease






