# WE HAVE A LOT TO BE THANKFUL FOR


Student Council wanted to show some love and thankfulness to teachers and staff this week by providing a harvest snack mix for them in the lounge!



**Eules Junior High** is teaming up with **Toys for Tots** by collecting new unwrapped toys to distribute to less fortunate children at Christmas.




