We had some very special visitors from the North Pole come spread some holiday cheer to our students. Thank you to Santa and his elf for a magical Friday!








NOVEMBER STUDENTS OF THE MONTH




Mr. Archey made us this ornament while watching the game and it is now on the tree in our front office!


