




JANUARY STUDENTS OF THE MONTH


RINEY'S STUDENTS EARN CERTIFICATIONS

Mrs. Riney's 7th grade Computer Science class finished their Cyber Safety training for the school year and earned 52 certifications!




RANDOM ACT OF KINDNESS WEEK

Thank you to EJH Student Council for helping us celebrate National Random Act of Kindness week with these great posters. We had dress up days every day this week.



2023-2024 TRANSFER AND SCHOOL OF CHOICE APPLICATION


The 2023-2024 transfer window opened January 5, 2023 and will close on March 10, 2023.
