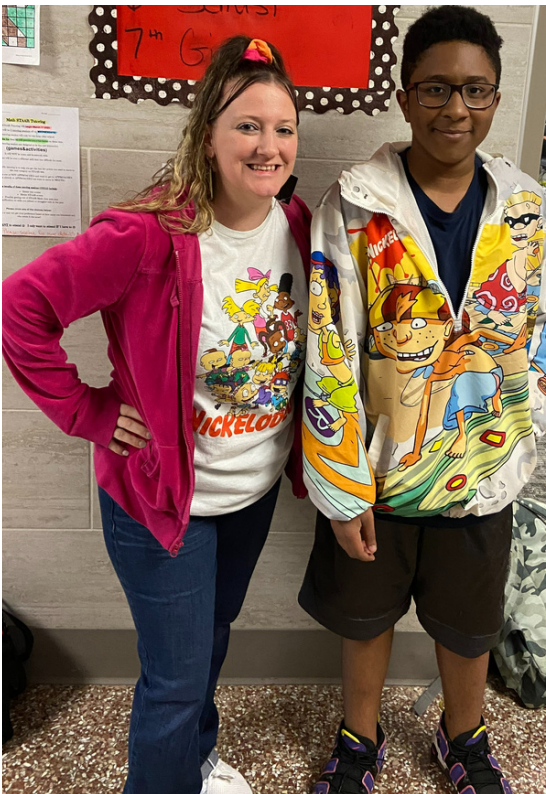
# SHOWING UP TAKES THE CAKE

# CELEBRATING OUR BUS DRIVERS

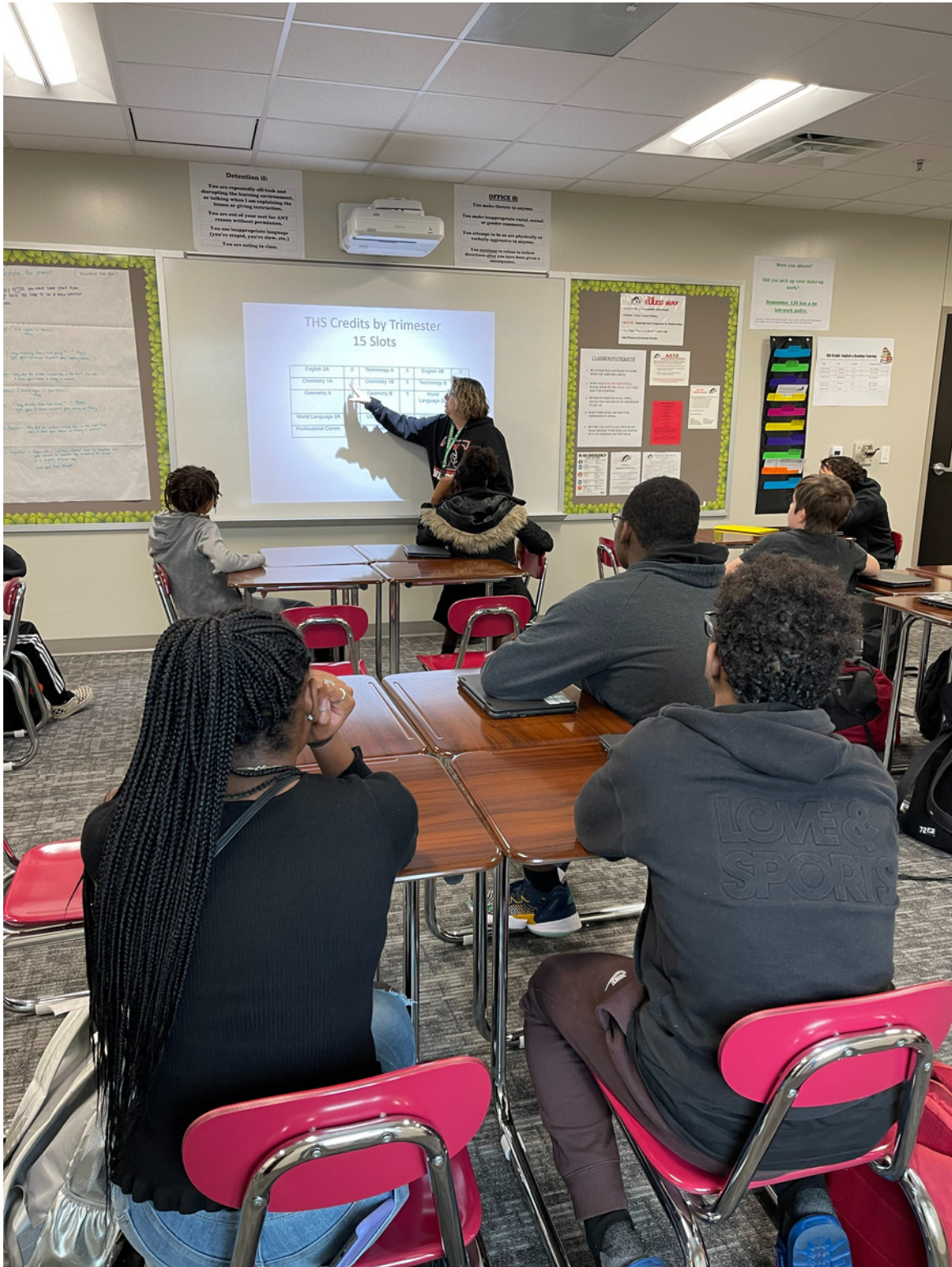

# JWAC WORLDQUEST

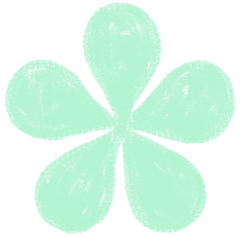

- March 10 for the Spring Dance in the EJJ cafeteria.

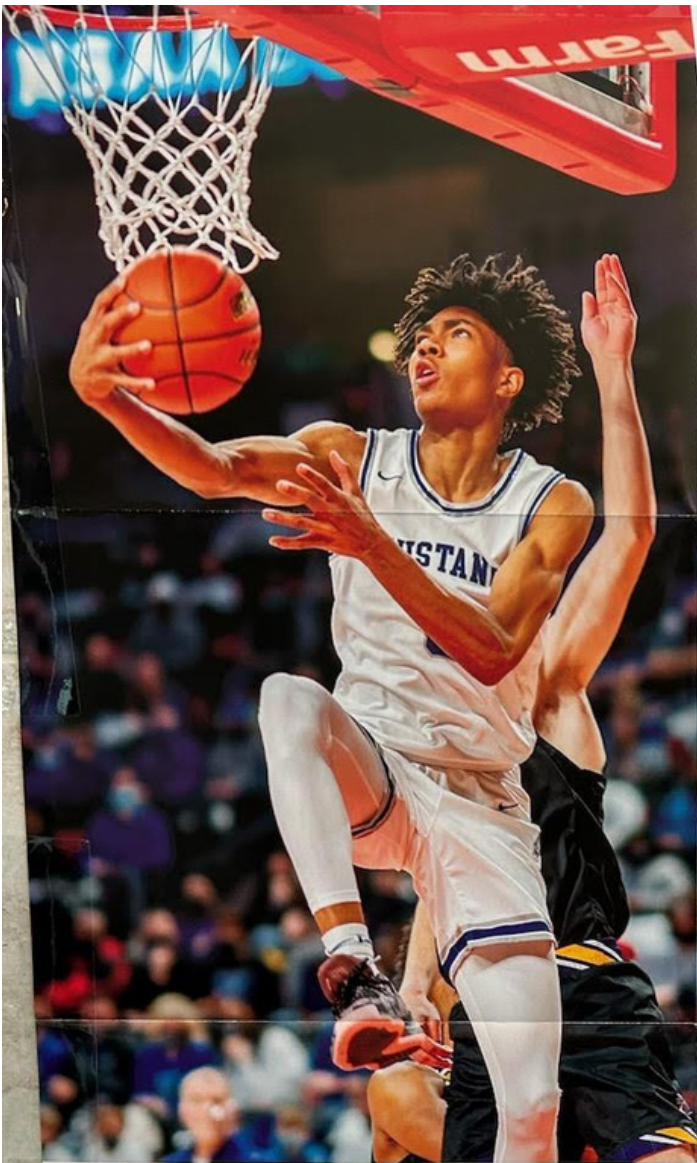
