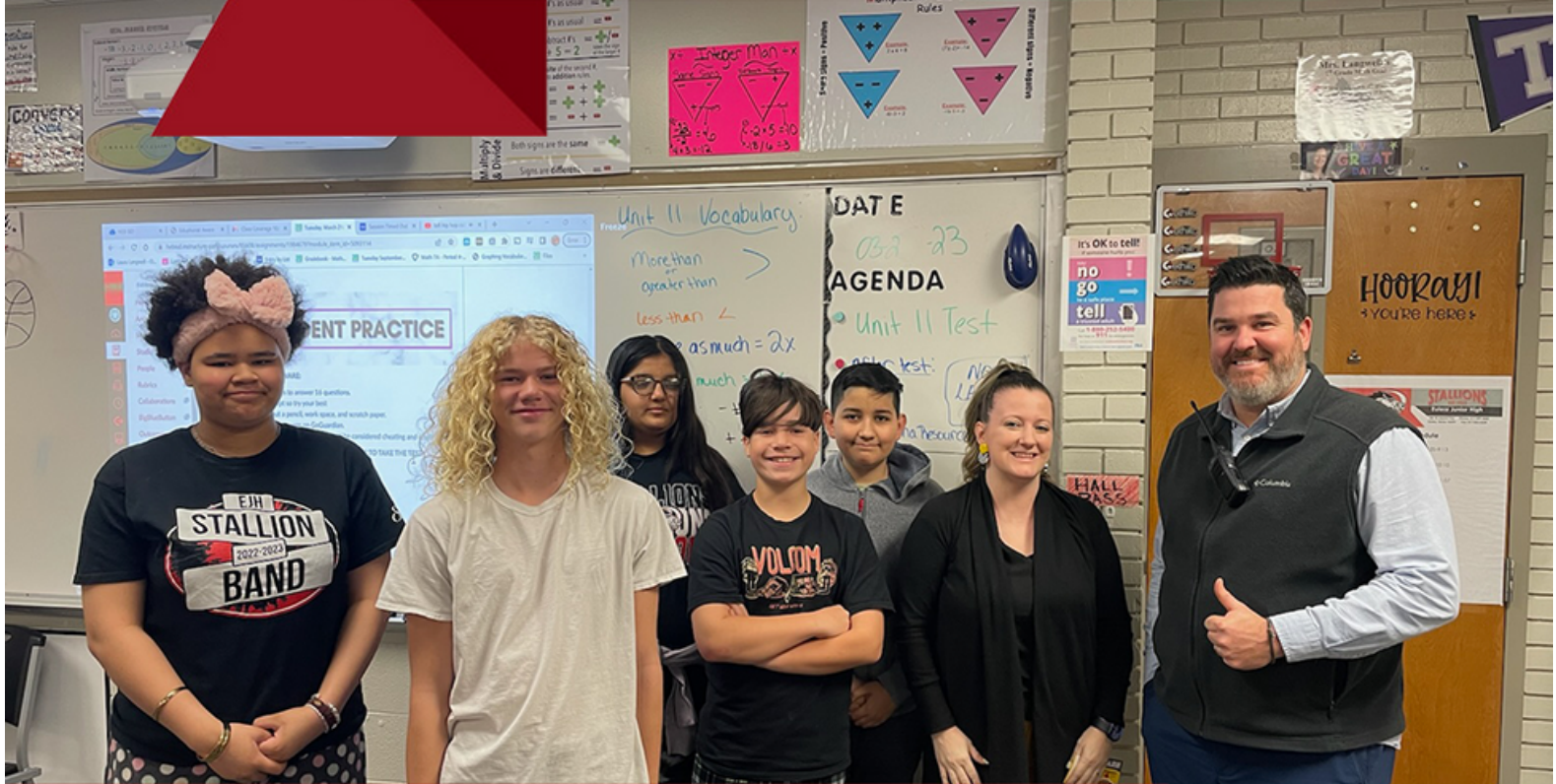

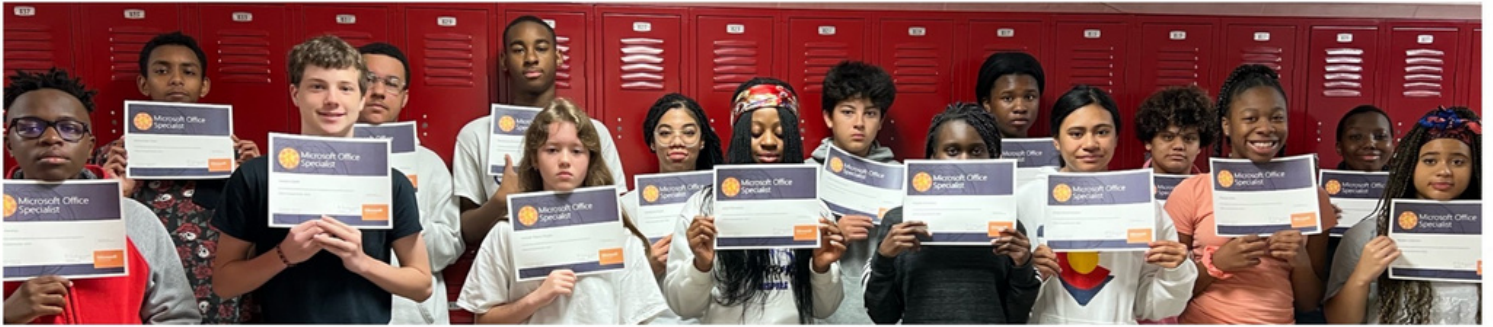

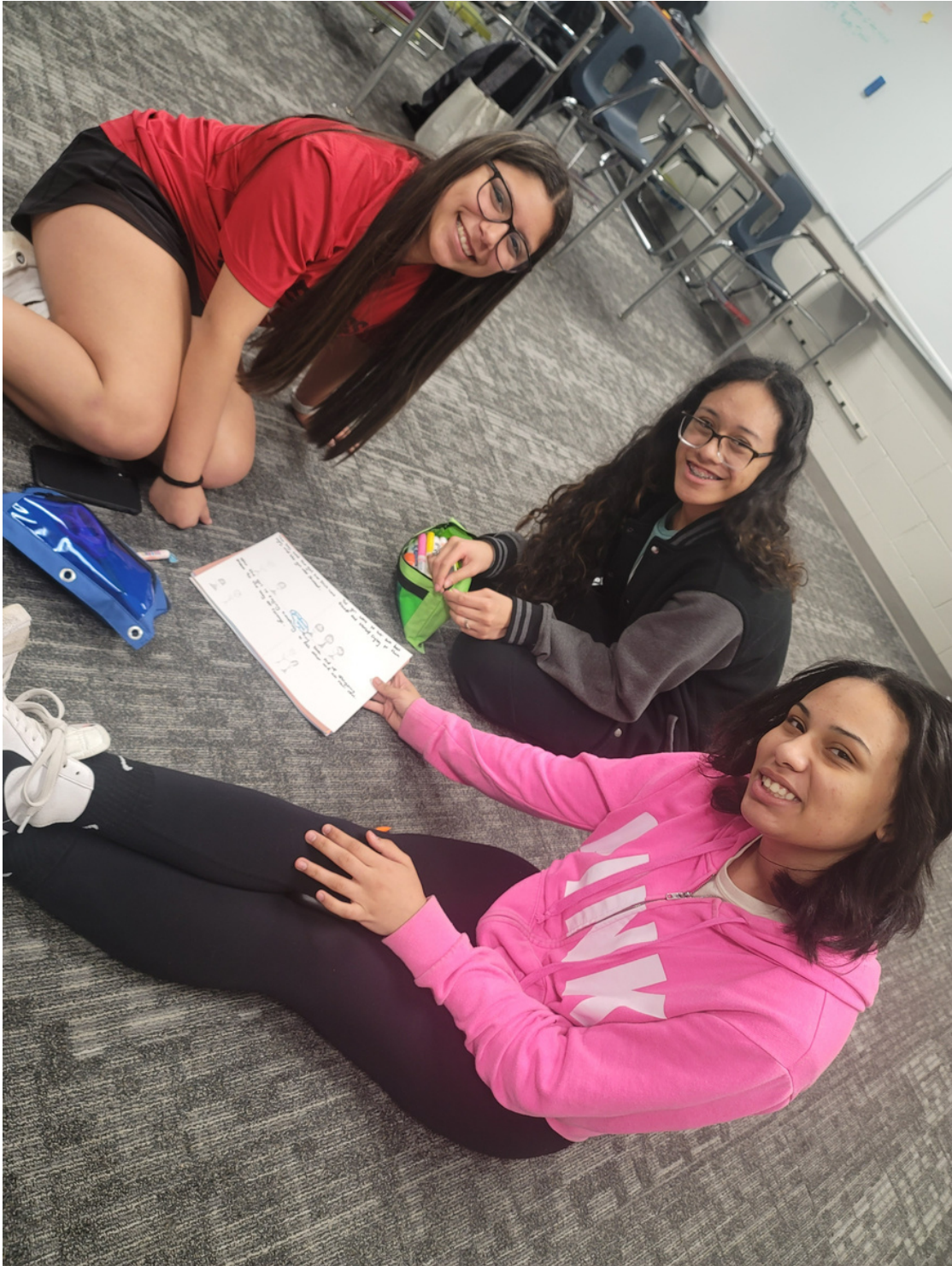
9TH GRADE CLASS PHOTO

Ms. Pryor's 8th graders are doing awesome!!! Some of her students are making a commercial about emotional terms!



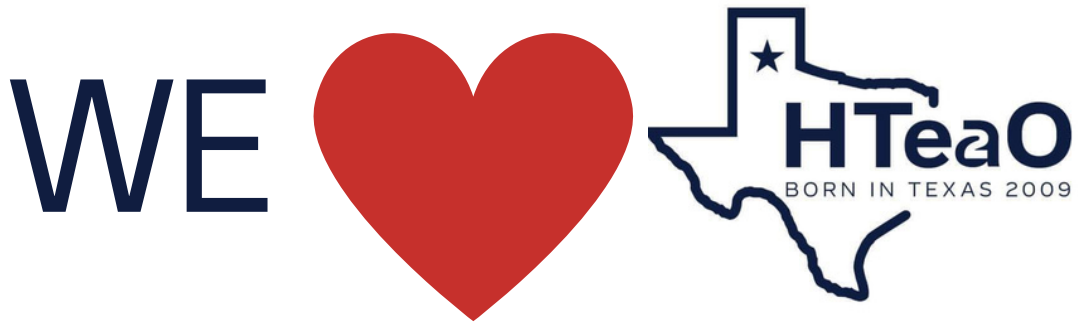
GOING THE EXTRA MILE

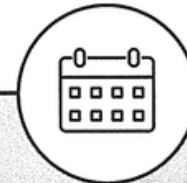

Officers need to arrive early, no later than 5:20 and Inductees by 5:45.

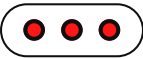
Those maintaining an 85 or above for all classes every 6 weeks and completing 10 or more service hours will be receiving an invitation for the induction.
