WELCOME TO THE NEW SCHOOL YEAR, STALLIONS!

The first day of school is Thursday, August 10th!

Student schedules will be posted on Monday, August 7th in **Home Access Center (HAC)**, where you can view grades and attendance. Any schedule that you see before this day will not be accurate.

Here are instructions on how to create a Home Access Center account

7th Grade Stallion Night will be on Thursday, August 3rd from 5-7 PM. Students new to EJV will have an opportunity to walk the campus, find their classes, and receive their Chromebook for the upcoming school year. This is also a great time to turn in immunization records.

Please note, paper schedules will not be handed out, but we will have people on campus to help students log into Home Access Center where schedules will be viewable. Please bring your cell phone or device!

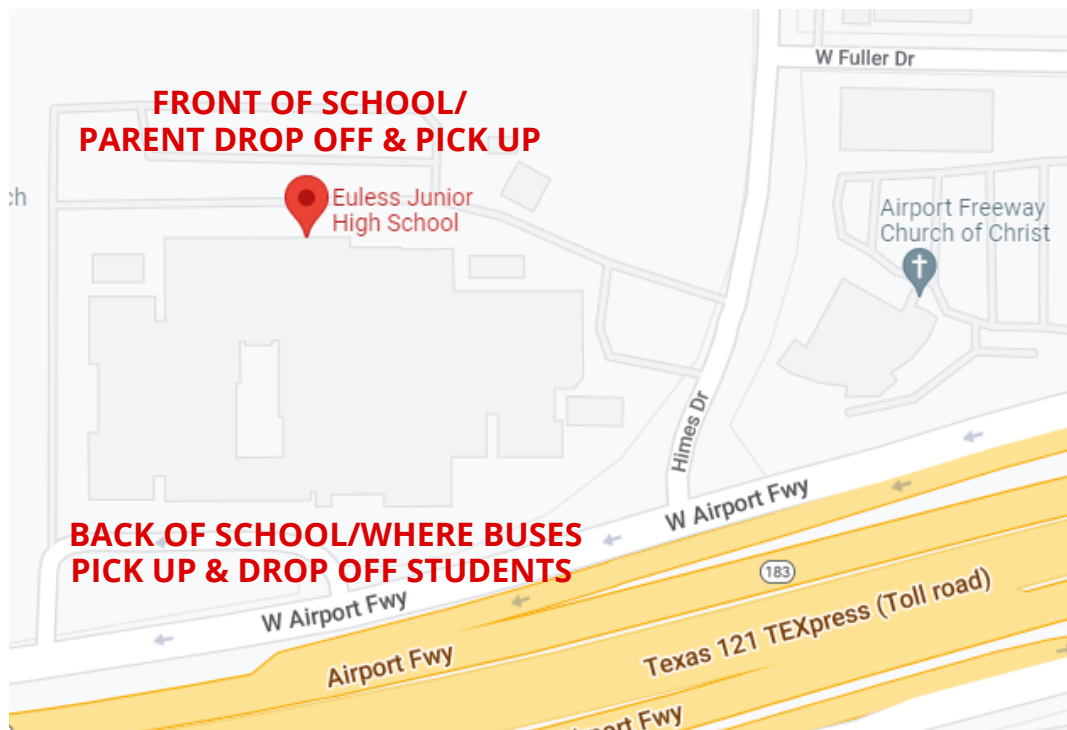
GETTING TO & FROM SCHOOL

Doors open at 7:45. Students will need to report to the cafeteria or tutoring until 8:00. If your student would like to eat breakfast, it is available in the cafeteria from 7:45-8:05 AM. At 8 AM students will be released from the cafeteria to report to their 1st period class. 1st period starts at 8:20. 7th period ends at 3:35 pm. Students being picked up by a parent/guardian or walking home will exit the front (north side) of the building. Students riding a bus will exit the back (highway side) of the building to load the buses. When they are running on time, buses leave at 3:45. Please understand our buses deliver elementary students first and will run late after school during the first week of school and occasionally throughout the school year.

Morning arrival/drop off is located at the front of the building (North side), and all students who are not bus riders will enter through the front doors.

Students will NOT be able to wait for a ride next door at Airport Freeway Church of Christ. If students are waiting on a ride, then they need to remain on campus.

SCHOOL SUPPLIES

There is no official school supply list for junior high. What we recommend is that each student comes with something to write with and something to write on for the first day, like a notebook and a pencil. They will receive their device on the first day and also learn more from each of their teachers about what supplies they are going to need for each class.

CELL PHONE POLICY

This is an excerpt from the [HEB ISD'S Student Handbook and Code of Conduct 2023-2024](#):

Possession of Telecommunications or Other Electronic Devices

Use of cell phones outside of individual classrooms will follow the guidelines below.

Grades 7-9 Students are required to keep their devices turned off and stored away during the school day. Cell phones may only be utilized in the classroom when the teacher deems appropriate as an instructional tool for educational purposes. Use of cell phones during passing periods and lunchtime will be an individual campus decision. Students who violate the campus policy will be subject to disciplinary actions.

Students shall not:

- Use a telecommunications device, including a cell phone, or other electronic device in violation of district and campus rules.
- Be in possession of cell phones during State Assessments, PSAT, SAT, ACT, AP AND IB tests.

Students can pick up their own devices the first time it is taken up at school, but on the second offense and every time after, parents/guardians are required to pick them up. The office is open for cell phone pickup between the hours of 7:45 am and 4 pm.

HEALTH CARE THINGS TO KNOW

GENERAL INFORMATION

Students should not call or text parents to pick them up for illness. The procedure is to go through the clinic for evaluation. Parents will then be called when necessary.

MEDICATION

- All medication (prescription and non-prescription) given at school requires a Request for Administration of Medication signed by a parent and physician. Information to be included is student's name, name of medication, dosage, time and route of administration. Form may be downloaded and printed from the **EJH Nurse website**.
- All medication must be in a properly labeled prescription container. Non-prescription medication must be in an original container.
- Temporary prescription medications (to be given at school for less than 10 days) may be given with a parent signed Request to Administer medication and the medication in a labeled medication bottle or discharge instructions from the prescribing physician.
- Inhalers and Epinephrine delivery systems may be carried by the student, especially in athletics, but documentation as described above is required.
- Students **MAY NOT** bring medication to school for self administration. **ALL** medication is to be brought to the EJH Clinic with appropriate documentation to be administered by the nurse. No medication will be returned to a student. This includes OTC medication and cough drops.

IMMUNIZATIONS

All students entering 7th grade have two additional immunizations required that were not required in elementary school. A Tetanus/pertussis immunization within the past 5 years and a Meningococcal vaccine.

HOME ACCESS CENTER

TUTORING

Tutoring times and rooms are posted in the hallways, in the Stallion Stampede weekly newsletter, and on teacher websites.

RETESTING

Except for Six Weeks and Semester tests, students may retake any major test they scored below a 70. The student must arrange a time with the teacher. The maximum grade for a test retaken is a 70.

ZERO-LOW GRADE MAKEUP

In the 5th week of each Six Weeks, students will have an opportunity to make up a zero or low grade from the daily grade category with a “zero-low grade make-up assignment”.

TARDY POLICY/LEAVING CLASS

Students should either be in the room when the bell rings or sitting at their desk when the bell rings. The teacher has communicated which of these they expect from your student.

- On the 3rd tardy to class during a six weeks, the student receives a detention. On the 4th tardy, they will receive a detention. On the 5th and 6th tardy, the student will receive a Tardy Hall. On the 7th tardy to a class during a six weeks, the student will be assigned ISS (In School Suspension).
- If a student needs to leave class, on the 3rd and ensuing occasions during the six weeks, the student’s administrator will be notified.
- Tardy and leave records clear every six weeks.
