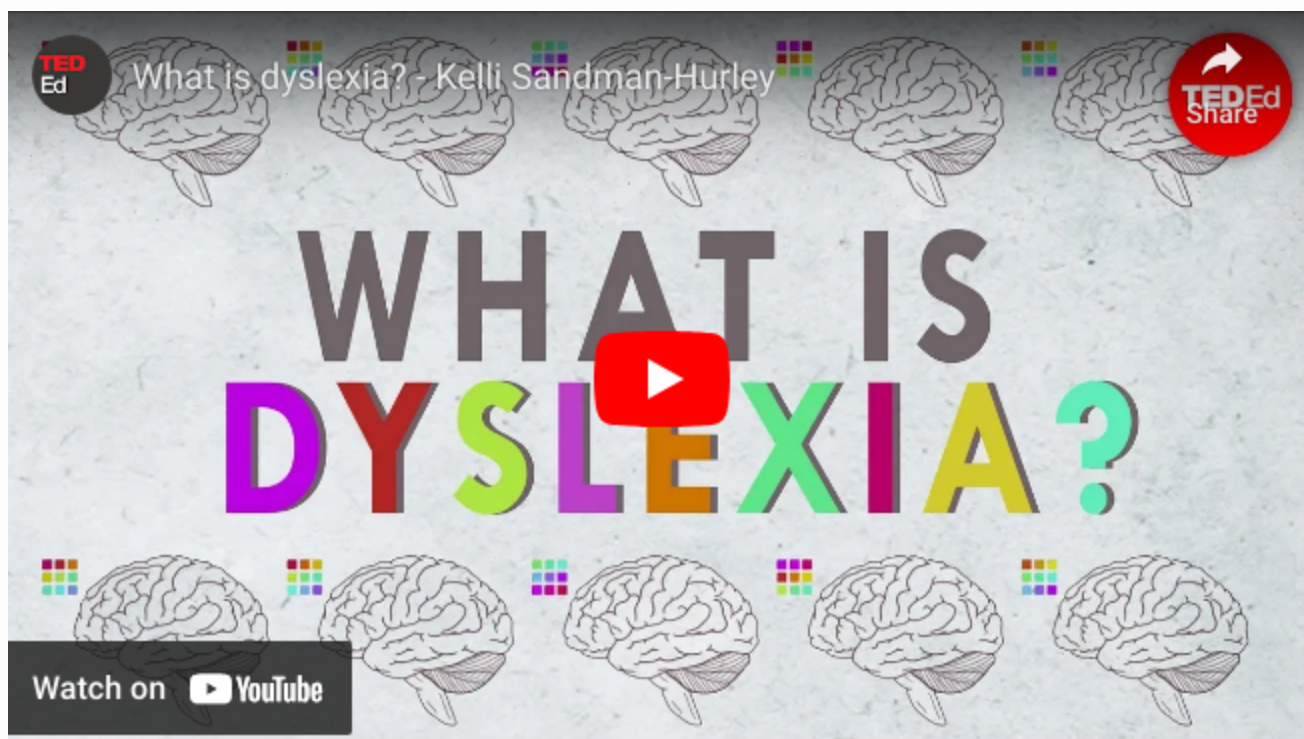

- A lifelong neurological disorder that can be managed, but not cured or outgrown
- Average to above average intelligence
 - Reading failure is unexpected when compared to other abilities
- Mainly affects reading, writing, and spelling
- Can affect automatic recall of stored facts, math calculations, comprehension, processing speed, and working memory
- Often comes with talents in art, music, problem solving, designing, and creating
- 10-20% of any population with an alphabetic language lives with dyslexia

Combined all classes donated 241 food items and \$224.69

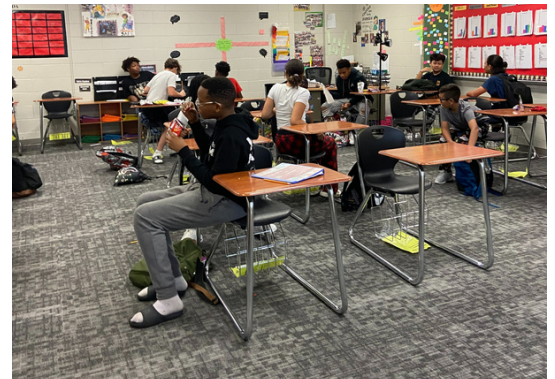
