**Children or Unaccompanied Youths That Live In Any Of The Following Situations:** \*In a shelter \* In a motel or campground due to the lack of an alternative adequate accommodation \* In a car, park, abandoned building, or bus or train station. \* Doubled up with other people due to loss of housing or economic hardship- may qualify for certain rights and protections under the federal McKinney-Vento Act. **Eligible children and youth have the right to:** Receive free, appropriate public education. \* Enroll in schools immediately, even if lacking documents normally required for enrollment. \* Enroll in school and attend classes while the school gathers needed documents. \* Enroll in the school school; or continue attending their school of origin (The school they attended when permanently housed or the school in which they were last enrolled) If that is your preference and is feasible. \* Transportation to and from the school of origin., if you request this. \* Receive educational services comparable to those provided to other students, according to the needs of the child or youth.
