

ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT CLASS RANKING

EIC (LOCAL)

Consistent Application for Graduating Class The District shall apply the same class rank calculation method and rules for local graduation honors for all students in a graduating class, regardless of the school year in which a student first earned high school credit.

Calculation

The District shall include in the calculation of class rank semester grades earned in high school credit courses taken at any grade level, except as excluded in this policy.

The calculation shall include failing grades.

Exclusions

The calculation of class rank shall exclude grades earned in summer school for credit recovery or in a local credit course. In addition, the calculation of class rank shall exclude grades earned in any course for which the content has been modified by a student's admission, review, and dismissal (ARD) committee in relation to the applicable essential knowledge and skills, as reflected in the student's individualized education program (IEP).

Weighted Grade System

In accordance with the provisions of this policy, the District shall give extra weight to each semester grade of at least 75 in eligible Advanced Placement (AP), dual credit, and Pre-AP courses.

All other eligible courses shall be categorized and weighted as Regular courses.

Weighted Numerical Grade Average

The District shall assign weights to semester grades and shall calculate a weighted numerical grade average in accordance with the following:

Category	Weight
AP and dual credit courses	plus 10 points
Pre-AP courses	plus 5 points
Regular courses	plus 0 points
Any semester grade below 75	plus 0 points

The District shall record unweighted numerical grades on student transcripts.

Transferred Grades

When a student transfers semester grades for courses that would be eligible under the Regular category and the District has accepted the credit, the District shall include the grades in the calculation of class rank.

ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT CLASS RANKING

EIC (LOCAL)

When a student transfers grades of at least 75 for courses that would be eligible to receive additional weight under the District's weighted grade system, the District shall assign weight to those grades based on the categories and grade weight system used by the District.

Local Graduation Honors

For the purpose of determining honors to be conferred during graduation activities, the District shall calculate class rank in accordance with this policy and administrative regulations at the end of the spring semester of the senior year.

For the purpose of applications to institutions of higher education, the District shall also calculate class rank as required by state law. The District's eligibility criteria for local graduation honors shall apply only for local recognitions and shall not restrict class rank for the purpose of automatic admission under state law. [See EIC(LE-GAL)]

Valedictorian and Salutatorian

The valedictorian and salutatorian shall be the eligible students with the highest and second highest rank, respectively. To be eligible for such recognition, a student must:

- Have been continuously enrolled in the District high school for the two school years immediately preceding graduation; and
- Have completed the foundation program with the distinguished level of achievement.

Ties

In case of a tie in weighted numerical grade averages after calculation to the fourth decimal place, the District shall recognize all students involved in the tie as sharing the honor and title.

Highest-Ranking Graduate

The student meeting the local eligibility criteria for recognition as the valedictorian shall also be considered the highest-ranking graduate for purposes of receiving the honor graduate certificate from the state of Texas.

Honor Graduates

The District shall recognize as an honor graduate each student who:

- 1. Has earned a cumulative weighted numerical grade average of at least 90:
- Has been continuously enrolled in the District high school for the two school years immediately preceding graduation; and
- 3. Has completed the foundation program with the distinguished level of achievement.
