# What Exactly is ESSER III?

ESSER III federal stimulus funding is intended to help public schools safely reopen and sustain the operation of schools and address the impact of the coronavirus pandemic on students.

*These one-time funds are projected to support the learning and emotional recovery of all Fabens ISD students over the next three years.*

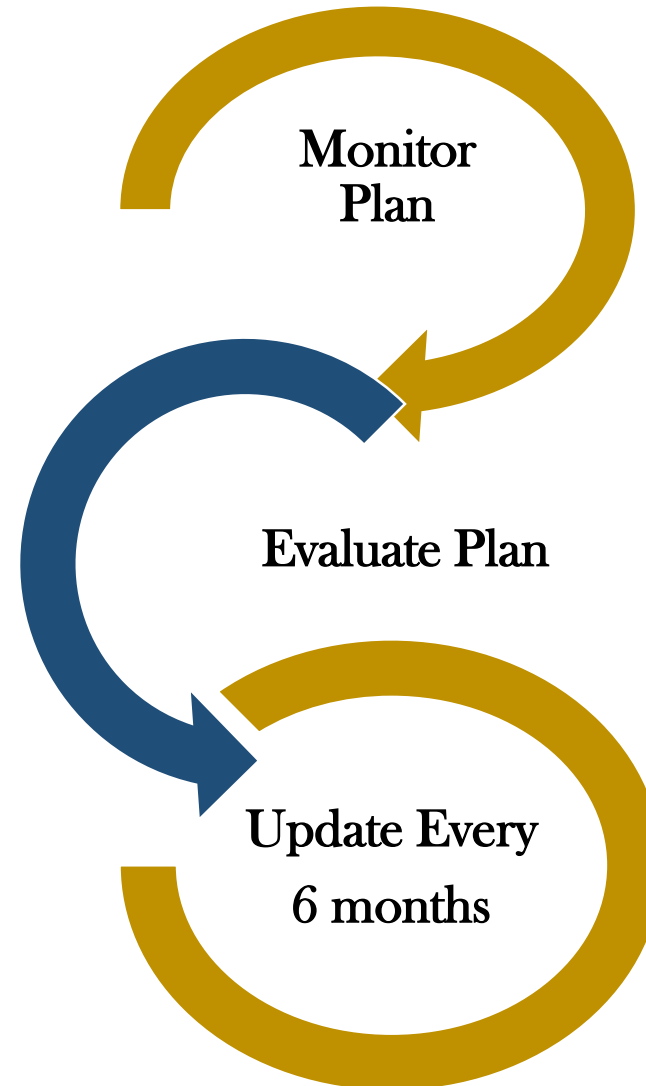
For example:
