




class! **CECELIA BARFIELD. 9TH GRADE**

Cory is a very respectful and responsible student who always gives 110%. His willingness to help others and his commitment to academics makes him a joy to have in class.


EMMA GULLETT. 7TH GRADE

They were led by Jake Fischer in 1st, then Matthew Kuhpolka in 2nd and lan Trejo in 3rd. Shortly thereafter, Julian Benero came in 8th and Jareth Terrones in 10th. The A team was rounded out by lan Haddock in 17th place. Next up the 8th grade B team, who also had a strong showing, with all boys finishing in the top 20! Gideon Prast placed 8th, Brady Cox 12th and Griffin Mentzer 18th. The 8th grade A team won first place as a team and are the District champs. These boys have now won back-to-back two HEB ISD cross-country championships.


