



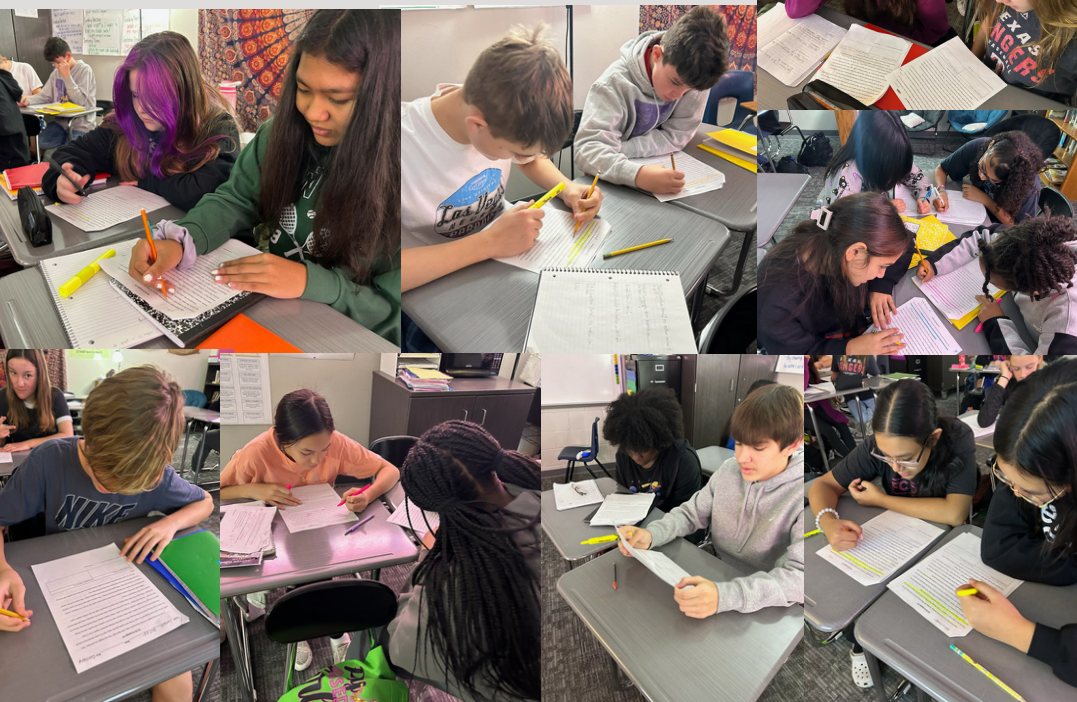

This past Wednesday, your Freshmen A Football Team finished the year strong with a 28-14 victory over the Bedford Broncos at LD Bell. After falling behind 7-0 in the first quarter, the Blackhawks scored on a run by Chayce Davis, but the try for two was no good. Chayce Davis added another touchdown, putting us down 12-14 going into the half.

The second half opened with Davis scoring on a 60+ yard touchdown run on the first play from scrimmage to put us up 20-14 after the attempt for two was successful. Gibson wouldn't be outdone as he tacked on another 60+ yard run that led to a 14-yard touchdown on his next carry. Trenton Turner tacked on the final two to put us up 28-14.

ANDREA ROCA, 8TH GRADE



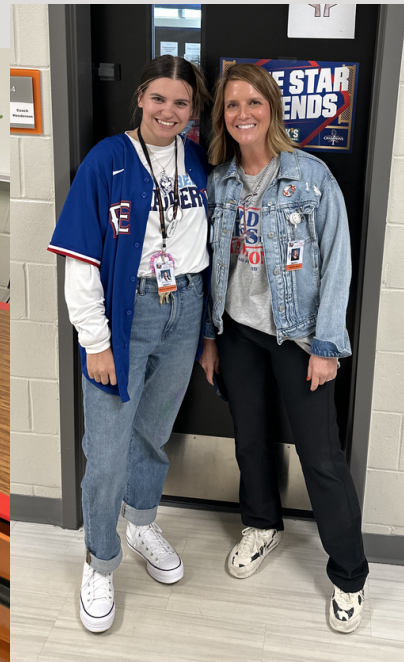
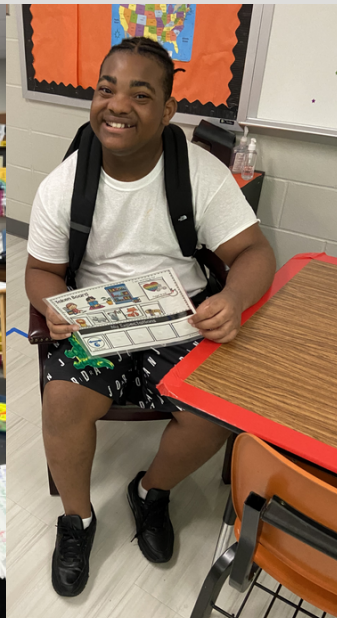
Andrea always does her best on her assignments, treats her peers with respect and always brings a big smile to class! It is a pleasure to have Andrea in my class.

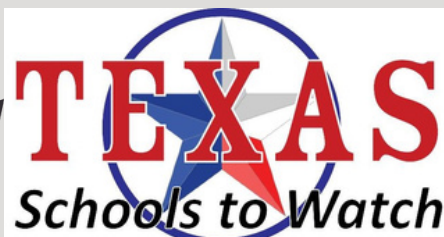
