GRADE CODES

Parents, please note in order to better assist you in interpreting grades in the grade book, Harwood Junior High has adopted a common terminology that you should see in all teachers' gradebooks. The explanation is as follows:

School Wide System for Zero Policy Grades: A Common Campus Vocabulary

"O" – for students who cannot make up assignments (for cheating or for earning an actual "O") "1" – for students who are going through the LWLD process (incompletes); potentially can become a "O" or a "50"

"X" - for students who are exempt from an assignment

"Z" - for students who were absent and can receive full credit
