



Pearland Junior High South National Junior Honor Society Selection Standards

Membership Process:

All Applicants:

- Must be enrolled in 2 PAP classes and have a 90 or higher in **ALL** courses for each grading period T1, T2, and T3. Your final grade (T1, T2, and T3) in **each** class must be a 90 or higher to qualify.
- Must have an S or E in citizenship for ALL grading periods T1, T2, and T3.
- Must not have served ISS, ALA, or outside school suspension.

Upon meeting eligibility criteria, candidates shall then be considered based on their service, leadership, character, and citizenship. However, the NJHS academic council reserves the right to review candidate information forms, faculty input, and other relevant information to determine those who fully meet the selection criteria for membership.

The NJHS academic council shall also reserve the right to award honorary membership to students who warrant special consideration—including those who receive accommodations for a disability or foreign exchange students—in recognition of achievement and/or outstanding service rendered to the school in keeping with the purposes of the National Honor Society.

After induction, to remain a member of NJHS members must:

- You may earn up to 10 hours over the summer, but the remaining 20 hours need to be earned over the course of the 2024-2025 school year.
- Regularly attend NJHS meetings.
- Maintain the NJHS pillars of scholarship, leadership, character, service, and citizenship.

Students who accept membership and are inducted into the chapter should be aware of the time and commitment involved with this honor.

The information submitted will be reviewed thoroughly by the Faculty Council. We are interested in students who are willing to exert the time and effort to complete the packet.

All fully completed information packets along with a copy of your last report card must be returned to Ms. Hall in room 2022 on or before 4:00 pm on **Friday, April 5, 2024**, for

consideration as a candidate in the National Junior Honor Society. Any information packet that is not fully completed and returned by Friday, **April 5, 2024, at 4:00 pm** will not be accepted, NO EXCEPTIONS. It is your responsibility to be thorough, honest, and accurate. If you have any questions, please take the time to visit with Ms. Hall.

Failure to comply with these standards will reflect negatively on your potential induction into the National Junior Honor Society.


1. List all school related clubs, teams, and extracurricular activities in which you participated during 7th grade.
