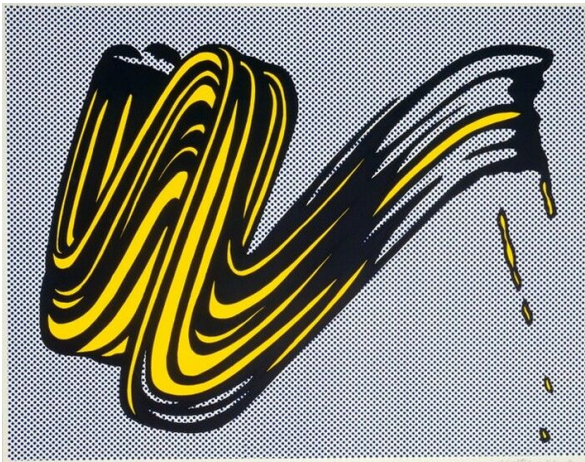
## Exploring Lines in Works of Art – A Museum Visit
