Thumbprint Family Tree

You will need:
One sheet of paper
Markers

This tree is looking pretty bare. Once we are done it is going to be full of leaves! This tree is going to represent you and your family. This could be a good opportunity to ask your family about your aunts, uncles, cousins and grandparents to add onto your tree. Follow the instructions below to create your beautiful tree. Use whatever colors that you feel represent your family best!

Instructions:

1. Print out the Family Tree printable on the next page.
2. If you do not have a printer available to use, you can draw your own tree!
3. Write "The (your last name) Family Tree" at the bottom.
4. Use washable markers to color on your fingers then press down on the paper to create leaves all around your family tree!
5. Feel free to add the names of you and your family all around the leaves.
6. After you are finished make sure you wash all of the marker off your fingers with warm soapy water.
