Drawing 3D Forms

The elements of art are to art what the ABCs are to reading. This project uses the element of FORM.

Art & Math Connection A 3D Drawing shows a subject in three dimensions: height, width, and depth. When you make a 3D Drawing, you are showing all sides of something, as well as where it is located in the space it occupies.

You will need:
Paper
Pencil

	<p>Step 1. Draw a simple shape (square, circle, trapezoid).</p>		<p>Step 2. Draw the same shape again, but this time draw it slightly above and to the right of this shape. It should overlap.</p>
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	<p>Step 3. Connect your two shapes by drawing lines from each corner.</p>		<p>Step 4. Add a shadow to your shapes well as a little shading beside to make it look like the shadow is being cast.</p>
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What other 3D shapes can you make? Can you name objects with that shape?
