



A Brief History

The history of Nonthaburi dates back 400 years to the era of the Ayutthaya Kingdom. Firstly known as Tambon Ban Talad Khwan, and noted for its fertile soil and wetlands where many birds nest alongside the Chao Phraya River, this tambon was promoted to Nonthaburi City in 1549 under the reign of King Mahajakrapat. Earthenware is a traditional product of Nonthaburi and can be seen in the provincial seal.

At the time of the Rattanakosin Kingdom, King Mongkut had Nonthaburi moved to the entrance of the Bang Sue Canal, where later in the reign of King Chulalongkorn, the city hall was founded and lasted till 1928. In the same year, King Pokklao initiated the idea of building a new city hall alongside the Chao Phraya River, which nowadays belongs to the Ministry of Interior Affairs. The building has become a relic of Thailand.







Food.

Enjoy a light lunch at Addicted Café after shopping at Central World, Chaengwattana, or if you fancy a change of scenery, why not try the unique Wood Café, with a great selection of fresh food and cakes. You could also try some local Thai food accessible from the Bypass road, less than 10 minutes from Nichada Thani.

Cakes.

If you have a sweet tooth, there are a number of great cake stores and bakeries in and around Nonthaburi. Inside Nichada Thani, you have Cherries and Starbucks, with many more great bakeries and coffee shops outside the front gate, including traditional English tea and scones at Tea Times a Charm.

Coffee.

If you enjoy not just good coffee but great coffee, Nonthaburi has many wonderful hidden gem coffee shops. Koh Kret is home to a range of amazing coffee shops; at some, you can even roast your own beans, grind them, and

If you want the option to sit outside in the sun or under the shade of trees, why not check out Rynn Kaffe, Koh Kret, or sit in a tree and enjoy lunch and a beverage at Tree's O'Clock?

Rynn Kaffe.

Rynn Kaffe is a few minutes away from Central Chaengwattana and serves excellent coffee, cakes, and has both indoor and outdoor seating. There is also a photo studio and boutique shop, called Mr. and Mrs., next to the café. They print large format high-quality photographs and as well as process black and white film.



Wood Cafe.

A little further afield but worth the journey, they have a menu with a good variety of high-quality fresh food and great sweets and treats.

Plantation Cafe.

This venue has a quaint English country-style garden and a coffee shop (Plantation Café) that overlooks a small pond. The cafe serves everything from food and cakes to craft beers. Just next door is an upper-end lobster restaurant and across the road yet another great restaurant.

Tea Times the Charm.

A few minutes away from Central Chaengwattana is a great little tea café serving English scones and a variety of high-end teas and coffees. You simply can't miss their high tea!





Tree's O'Clock.

Dine in a tree at Tree's O'Clock, they have a Thai and Western menu.

Jim's Burger.

Simple, delicious burgers and a selection of craft beers.

Local experenice.

Fishing and Thai food at Chokeanan Fishing, Pakkret, also known as "The Fish Pond," offers local Thai food with the option of a day of fishing.

Hidden Backyard.

Great setting to enjoy food and an array of craft beers with friends.

Breeze Cafe & Bar.

A lively dinner on the lake's edge, outside of IMPACT Arena and next to

IMPACT Speed Park (Go-Karting).



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KOH KRET.

Koh Kret, otherwise known as pottery island, is a small island that is a 20-minute cycle or 15-minute drive away from Nichada Thani. The island is a great city escape and has a host of fun activities for everyone.



Coffee shops.

Why not try your hand at coffee bean roasting? One of the few places in Thailand where you can roast the beans yourself, and make your own special cup of joe. It's a fun experience for the family or a group of friends. A number of fantastic coffee shops scattered around the island could easily lead to a day of coffee shop hopping.

Craft beer.

Home of Chit Beer, one of the few breweries in Thailand that brew their own beer. They also serve food. What's best is it's situated right on the river for a perfect afternoon chill!

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Pottery workshops, traditional Thai artists and potters, markets, restaurants, and bike rentals to cycle around the island - these are just a few of the fun activities you can do on a day out Koh Kret.

MUSEUMS & TEMPLES.

MOCA Bangkok is a contemporary museum of art showcasing a range of traditional and modern artwork from local and international artists around the world. There are many more museums around Nonthaburi: SilpSiam (Koh Kret),; Museum of Nonthaburi, Tooney Toy Museum, and the Nonthaburi Old City Hall. Temples are plentiful as well, Wat Sangkhathan, Wat Bua Khwan, and Wat Chomphuwek, to name a few.





Little Barn.

This is not just a coffee shop with a kid's playground, Little Barn offers weekend workshops and an array of fun activities for kids.

Sweet Poppy.

An Australian-inspired oasis, just a golf cart drive from Nichada Thani. You can find great food, drinks, and an adventure playground for the kids.

Tooney Toy Museum.

Home to an extensive collection of action figures, cartoon-inspired dolls, cars, life-sized and oversized toy models, with an outside playground and indoor play area for the little ones. A visit here would make for a fun day out with the family.

10 minutes by car

Pang U Bon to see the water lilies, followed by lunch at sweet poppy.

10 - 20 minutes by car

Bars and craft beer with a local twist can be found at Turtle Bar, AKKEE, Beergasm, Tawandang German Brewery, Mitr Brewery, and Devanom Farm. Koh Kret island (30 mins) is the home of Chit Beer brewery.



10 minutes by car

iCAFE for a coffee and breakfast followed by fishing and local Thai lunch at Chokeanan Fishing.

20 minutes by car

Coffee at DEK-CHA followed by a couple of hours of indoor rock climbing, then a light lunch on the way home at Mana Sushi on Soi Samakkee.

30 minutes by car

Sub Zero ice-skating, bowling or a movie at the Tesco Lotus Tiwanon. You could also pop into Decathlon, one of the biggest outdoor supply stores, while you are there.





10-30 minutes by car

Lunch at In-Dus-Three (10 minutes from ISB), followed by a speedy few laps around the IMPACT SPEED PARK track (15 minutes from In-Dus-Three).

20-30 minutes by car

Shopping at Macro, craft beer, and dinner at Hidden Backyard.

30-45 minutes by car

Urban biking at Peppermint Bike Park, followed by lunch (and craft beer for the parents) at Plantation Cafe and Roastery.
