Science National Honor Society (SNHS) is a national organization honoring and encouraging student excellence in science. Institutions nation-wide recognize SNHS members as scientific leaders in their high school as well as in their community. The objectives of Parkview's Chapter of the Science National Honor Society are to:

- encourage and recognize scientific and intellectual thought
- advance students' knowledge of classical and modern science
- communicate with the scientific community
- aid the civic community with its comprehension of science
- encourage students to participate in community service, and in turn, encourage a dedication to the pursuit of scientific knowledge that benefits all humankind

To be eligible for and maintain membership in SNHS, members must:

- be sophomores, juniors or seniors.
- have a minimum OVERALL GPA of 3.5 (without rounding).
- have an average of an A (90% or better) in all science courses.
- have a clean discipline record with no infractions.
- be willing to donate 6 hours of service per semester for a total of 12 service hours for the year.
- be willing to donate your time to tutor other students in science as a part of your service hours.
- have taken or plan on taking an AP Science course before you graduate
- get positive recommendations from 2 previous teachers (one MUST be a science teacher)
- attend all meetings. You are able to miss a maximum of two meetings.

If the objectives of SNHS are of interest to you, and you meet the aforementioned eligibility requirements, please do the following by

- ✓ complete the 2-page SNHS application
- ✓ get TWO teacher recommendations (one must be from a science teacher)
- ✓ Ask your advisement teacher to send Dr. Sell a copy of your high school transcript.
- ✓ get everything submitted by

Unfortunately, late applications will NOT be considered. You will be personally notified via letter in Guided Study to officially inform you whether or not your application has been accepted; simply filling out the application and turning it in does NOT guarantee membership.
