


World Down Syndrome Day on 3.21







Updated COVID-19 Guidance

In alignment with the March 2024 updates from the CDC and the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE), we have updated our guidance for students and staff who test positive for COVID-19. The updated guidance aligns



recommendations for a range of viral respiratory illnesses such as Flu and RSV.

If someone tests positive for COVID, Flu, RSV, or is experiencing any respiratory illness

- They should stay home until symptoms are improving and for at least 24 hours after fever has resolved without the use of fever-reducing medications
- When going back to normal activities, <u>take added precautions</u> over the next five days, such as hand and respiratory hygiene, masks, physical distancing, and/or testing when you will be around other people indoors.

Please remember, regardless of COVID status - stay home when sick You can find more information on COVID-related illness and other common illnesses and guidelines for school attendance in CDPHE's <u>How Sick is Too Sick</u> and through your school's health team.

- Debe permanecer en casa hasta que los síntomas mejoren y durante al menos 24 horas después de que la fiebre se haya resuelto sin el uso de medicamentos antifebriles.
- Cuando vuelva a sus actividades normales, <u>tome precauciones adicionales</u> durante los próximos cinco días, como higiene de manos y respiratoria, uso de tapabocas, distanciamiento físico y/o pruebas cuando vaya a estar cerca de otras personas en espacios cerrados.

Por favor, recuerde, independientemente de su estado de COVID, permanezca en casa cuando esté enfermo.
