
**Lt. Frederick F. Bangert (1938)**

Commissioned May 23, 1944, Fort Sumner, New Mexico. Went overseas January, 1945. A pilot of a B-26 Marauder bomber, was killed in action near Schwenningen, Germany, April 12, 1945.



**Pvt. Aloysius J. Berce (1943)**

Entered ASTP — after completing training for Infantry Patrol at Camp Livingston, La. He was sent to England in September 1944 for assignment to the front. He served with the infantry in Holland and Belgium—was killed in action in Germany on November 6, 1944.



**Cpl. Thomas J. Berg (1941)**

Enlisted in Marine Corps in August, 1941, boot training received at San Diego, California. Served in South Pacific as a radio code operator. Killed in action at invasion of Tarawa, Gilbert Islands in November of 1943.



**Pvt. Robert P. Brady (1942)**

Entered service on February 16, 1943. Received basic training at Camp Roberts, California. Sent overseas June 25, 1943. Member of the heavy weapons branch of the infantry, he was killed in action in the battle of northern Luzon on March 8, 1945.



**Seaman 2/C Peter R. Braun (1945)**

Joined Navy January 2, 1945—Boot training at Great Lakes—went to Pharmacists' mate Corps school at Naval Hospital, San Diego, California—died of spinal meningitis April 30, 1945.



**Major Richard J. Christman (1939)**

Wings at Kelly Field, August 1942. 55 missions as pilot of B-25 in Africa; returned to Air Service Command, January 1945, sent as Com. Of. of repair Squadron to India. Died Oct. 17, 1945 on a mercy mission. Distinguished Flying Cross, Presidential Citation and Purple Heart posthumously.



**Lt. George E. Cronin (1939)**

Left M.U. to join Air Corps on November 10, 1942. Graduated as navigator of a Flying Fortress—Commissioned as Second Lieutenant—Assigned as instructor to San Marcus Field, Texas. While acting as a navigator on a Mitchell bomber, was killed in action off the coast of the Southwest Pacific island of Moratai on December 26, 1944.



**Lt. Alfred J. Daleke (1939)**

Went into Service September 28, 1942—attended bombardier school at Big Spring, Tex., and was graduated November 29, 1943. Assigned to overseas duty in South West Pacific Area, killed in action on his 18th mission over Truk Island, June 18, 1944.



**Lt. John I. Drew, Jr. (1934)**

Joined Navy 1939—commissioned Ensign 1940—assigned to aircraft carrier U. S. S. Lexington which was sunk in Battle of the Coral Sea. Served a year on a destroyer—entered Naval Air Corps and received wings at Pensacola, Fla., Oct. 1943. As a pilot instructor in the Navy Air Corps, he failed to return to his Rhode Island base from a routine night flight over the Atlantic on December 10, 1944.



**Lt. Joseph D. Esser (1937)**

A member of one of the first group of enlistees leaving Milwaukee on April 13, 1942. Received his wings and was commissioned Second Lieutenant at Stockton field, California, January 1943. He was killed in a B-26 bomber crash near MacDill Field, Tampa, Fla., on June 1, 1943.



**Lt. Col. J. R. (Bob) Fitzsimmons  
(1914)**

Died October 20, 1945 of coronary sclerosis at New Malir, India, en route to the United States—fought in World War I in Archangel, Russia—enlisted in World War II as a major and was advanced to Lieutenant Colonel in Burma where he worked with truck convoys on the Burma road.



**Lt. John W. France (1940)**

Attended the Marquette School of Engineering—joined the Army Air Corps in June 1942—received training at Biloxi, Mississippi, Indiana Central College, San Antonio and Ellington Field, Texas—received navigator's wings and his commission in May 1944. He left the states for Tinian in March 1945—reported missing in action over Tokyo, May 26, 1945.



**Lt. Max R. Grefig (1937)**

Trained at Maxwell Field, Nashville, Tenn., Avon Park, Fla., Monroe, La., and Barksdale Field, La., after entering service in October 1942—graduated as a Navigator and commissioned at Monroe, La., January 1944—left for overseas from California August 3, 1944—was killed in action over the Celebes Islands on February 16, 1945.



**Capt. Anthony J. Gramling (1931)**

Enlisted February 1942, after serving briefly at Fort Knox, Ky., went to Ireland in June 1942 and to England shortly afterward—took part in the North African invasion, landing at Oran—participated in eight major engagements in North Africa and was cited for "exceptional and meritorious service under fire" in caring for and evacuating the wounded in the battle of Kasserine pass—was killed in action January 10, 1944 in Italy.



**Lt. Robert J. Griesell (1939)**

Took primary flight training at Thunderbird field, Arizona, received wings and was commissioned in April 1943 at La Junta. Killed on June 21, 1943, in the crash of a training plane at an advanced flying school near La Junta, Colorado.



**Cpl. Richard P. Grutza (1939)**

Enlisted in Air Corps the day after Pearl Harbor, December 8, 1941—received training as a radio operator—killed in action in Australian area, December 5, 1942.




**Pvt. William M. Holleran (1943)**

Entered service March 30, 1944—Basic Training at Camp Hood, Texas—sent overseas September 1944, assigned to 117th Infantry, 30th Division, 9th Army—killed in action December 19, 1944 at Stavelot, Belgium.



**Pfc. Stephen G. Holzburger (1940)**

Entered army, September 10, 1942—Basic Training at Fort Bragg, N. C., Amphibious truck company training at Moultrieville, So. Carolina—went overseas in December, 1943. Killed during a rehearsal of the invasion of Germany in the English Channel when German "E" boat attacked their craft, April 28, 1945.




**Lt. John L. Huber (1942)**

Entered Service (Army Air Corps) 1943—graduated as a bombardier and commissioned at Carlsbad, N. Mexico, April 1, 1944—attached to 15th Air Force—killed in action over Linz, Austria, November 11, 1944 on his 24th mission—awarded the Air Medal with Oak Leaf cluster, Presidential unit citation, and posthumously the Purple Heart.



**Capt. Edmund F. Janic (1934)**

The first high school graduate to qualify as a flying cadet—1941—bombardier and 2nd Lt. at Midland, Texas, 1942. Silver Star, Purple Heart, Dist. Flying Cross with Oak Leaf Cluster, Air Medal with three clusters and Presidential Citation—Died Oct. 23, 1945, Fitzsimmons General Hospital, Denver.



**Pfc. Donald J. Jazdzewski (1938)**

Entered service (Marine Corps) on January 11, 1943. Received boot training at Camp Elliott, San Diego, California. Received Purple Heart for wounds suffered in Tarawa invasion. Was killed in action with the Marines at Saipan on June 27, 1944.




**PO 3/C Jerome E. Lademan (1938)**

Enlisted in Navy in June, 1942. Received training as signalman at Butler University, Indianapolis, Indiana and Norton Heights, Connecticut. Went overseas in January, 1943. Reported killed when his ship was torpedoed in the Arabian Sea, June 21, 1943.



**Lt. Gerald J. Leshok (1937)**

Enlisted in Navy, April, 1943—Commissioned at Columbia, University, New York in July, 1943—Left states on convoy duty, September, 1943—Radar technician, assigned to duty in South Pacific, October, 1944—Died December 10, 1944, from wounds received in action on December 7, 1944.




**Ensign Peter B. McConville (1943)**

Injured fatally while returning from a ferry flight to the naval air station at Clinton, Oklahoma on October 31, 1945. Enlisted as naval air cadet in 1943 and trained at Marquette University and Iowa. Was commissioned in March, 1944 at Pensacola, Florida, at the completion of pre-flight training. Was an assistant instructor in dive-bombing at Cecil Field, Jacksonville, Florida.




**Pvt. John E. McDermott (1940)**

Left Marquette University with the E.R.C. March 4, 1943—trained at Ft. Sheridan, Atlantic City, N.J. (Air Corps Basic) Cincinnati, Tinker Field, Okla., and an air field at Denver, Colorado before going overseas to Hawaii in May 1945—was returned to Letterman's General Hospital, San Francisco, California in July 1945 where he died August 4, 1945 from Malaria and complications.




**Pvt. William T. McElwee (1932)**

Entered Army February 22, 1944. Received basic training at Fort McClellan, Alabama. Overseas August 10, 1944. Assigned to E. T. O. First Army, 28th Infantry, Company D. Killed in action on November 29, 1944, in the Hurtgen Forest and Roer River Dams fighting. He was buried in Henri Chappelle Cemetery in Belgium.



**Lt. Neale F. Maloney (1940)**

Entered service in February, 1943. Received his wings, commissioned Second Lieutenant on March 12, 1943 at Williams Field, Chandler, Arizona. Assigned to 15th Air Force, August, 1944. Pilot of a P-38 fighter. Killed in action over Nis, Yugoslavia, September 2, 1944 while strafing enemy vehicles.




**Lt. William H. Millmann (1936)**

1943 graduate M. U. Medical School—Interned at St. Mary's Hospital—entered service August 7, 1944. Trained at Carlisle Barracks, Pa., and Camp Swift, Tex.—went overseas on January 3, 1945 with 87th Mountain Infantry—Surgeon of 3rd battalion—awarded Silver Star for repeatedly leaving cover under intense German fire to give aid to casualties—was killed in action February 21, 1945.



**Ens. Robert H. Mooney (1938)**

Entered Navy on June 26, 1942 immediately after graduation from Marquette University. Was commissioned ens'gn on February 17, 1943 at Columbia University, New York. He was assigned to sea duty on a destroyer on May 4, 1943. Died of wounds received in action on December 26, 1943.




**Pvt. Martin W. O'Connell (1941)**

Entered service on March 10, 1943. Received basic training at Camp Butler, North Carolina. From there he went to Camp Pickett, Virginia. Was sent overseas in September, 1944—attached to a medical detachment of the 78th (Lightning) division—was killed in the European theater on February 6, 1945.




**Lt. Edward C. Plevak (1939)**

Took bombardier training at Childress Field, Texas, and Dyesburg Field, Tennessee from 1942 to 1944. Went overseas in July of 1944. Winner of Air Medal and Oak Leaf cluster for heroic service over France and Germany. Was killed in action over Germany on September 30, 1944.



**Lt. Herbert K. Potts (1938)**

Joined Army Air Force, July, 1942—trained at San Antonio, Texas. Received wings on December 5, 1943 at Waco, Texas. In August, 1944, was sent overseas as pilot on a Liberator. Killed in action September 27, 1944, on his third mission.



**Pvt. Thomas Powers (1944)**

A member of the 95th Infantry Division of General Patton's Third Army, he died in the battle of Metz, France on November 17, 1944.



**Lt. Gordon Rohn (1929)**

Entered service on March 23, 1942 and received his training at Fort Knox, Kentucky, where he graduated and was commissioned on October 24, 1942. He was sent overseas in the early part of 1943. While an officer of a tank unit, he died in Italy on July 13, 1944, of wounds inflicted in action on July 5.



**PO 1/C Mark E. Schmidt (1930)**

Entered Navy in 1942. Spent two years at Naval Base in Guantanamo Bay, Cuba. Died as a result of injuries received in an automobile accident in Philadelphia on June 18, 1945.



**Lt. Harry J. Senecal (1937)**

Enlisted in Army Air Corps on November 5, 1940. Graduated a bombardier on a B-25 and was commissioned Second Lieutenant on November 5, 1942. Assigned to overseas duty in North African theater, April, 1943. Died of wounds received in action over Italy, November 20, 1943.



**Sgt. Donald W. Shinners (1941)**

Began basic training February 20, 1943 at Miami Beach, Florida. Received other training at Denver, Colorado, Kearney, Nebraska, and Las Vegas, Nevada. Flew overseas to England on December 26, 1943. As waist gunner on a Flying Fortress, he died in service on return from his first mission over Germany in February, 1944.




**Sgt. Arthur H. Smith (1938)**

Entered service on May 26, 1942. Received basic training at Camp Shelby, Mississippi, and from there went to Louisiana and California. He was sent overseas in December of 1943 and was killed in infantry action in Italy on May 5, 1944.



**Lt. Richard J. Stroebel (1938)**

Enlisted in Army Air Corps in March, 1942. Commissioned December 12, 1942 at Williams Field, Chandler, Arizona. As bombardier on a Flying Fortress, he was killed in a plane crash, on a flight to the European theater, in the ocean off the coast of Scotland on June 6, 1943.



**Flight Officer Casimir L. Szaj (1943)**

Entered service on July 5, 1943. Received training at Keesler Field, Mississippi, Shreveport, Louisiana, Shepard Field, Texas, and Houston, Texas. He graduated and received his wings from Childress, Texas. Was sent overseas to England in November of 1944—completed 36 missions as a bombardier on a B-24 Liberator bomber—was killed in action on April 19, 1945.



**Lt. Eugene A. Szaj (1940)**

Left Marquette University on March 10, 1942 to join Army Air Force. Was stationed at Fresno, California. Died on December 28, 1943 in an army hospital at Bakersfield, California from injuries suffered in an automobile accident.



**Lt. Stehling N. Wahlen (1938)**

Enlisted in Army Signal Corps Reserves on May 18, 1942. Received training in Chicago, Camp Crowder, Missouri, and Fort Monmouth, New Jersey, where he was commissioned in September of 1943. In March of 1944 he was assigned to the Army Air Corps and took training in Texas. A navigator on a B-24 bomber, he was killed in action August 1, 1945, over the Celebes.



**Lt. Richard J. Wanvig (1933)**

Enlisted in Air Corps in March, 1942. Received his training at Eagle Pass, Texas, where he was commissioned in April of 1943. Was sent overseas on August 4, 1943 and was killed in action October 30, 1943 in his Thunderbolt P-47 over the European Theater.



**Lt. John E. Wright (1941)**

Enlisted in Army Air Corps. Took pilot's training at Miami Beach, Florida and the University of Arkansas and various flying fields in Texas before graduation and commissioning. Flew to base in Burma in November of 1944. Was killed in plane crash over Himalaya Mountains in India on December 19, 1944.
