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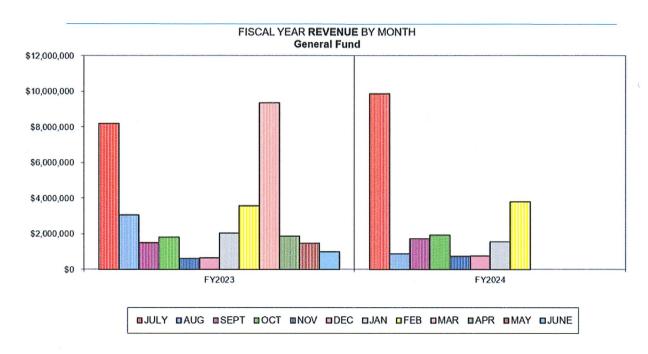

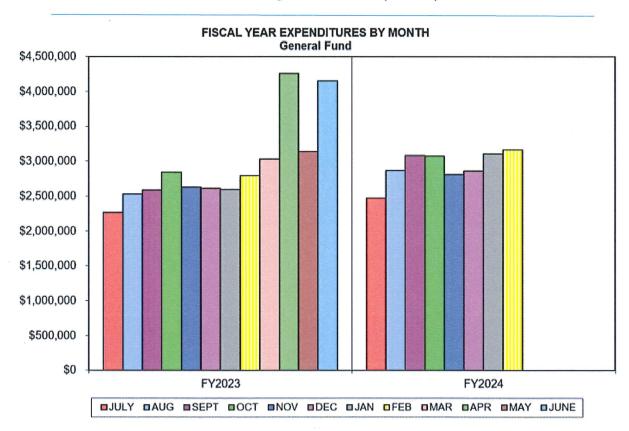

Revenue is **6% higher** than February of last year.

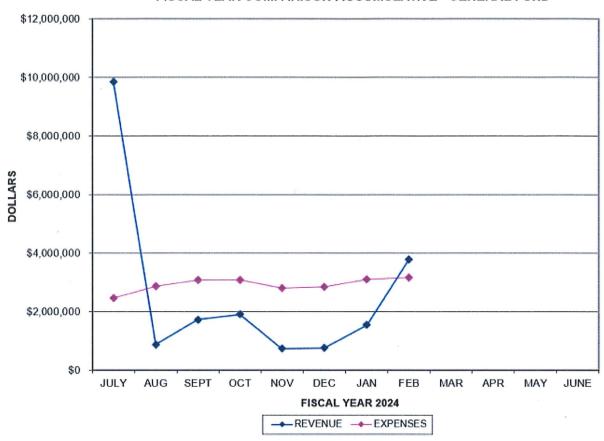


Expenditures are 13% higher than February of last year.

#### **Summary Analysis:**

For the month of February, Revenue was 6% higher than February of last year, while Expenditures were 13% higher. Some months are typically higher or lower than others, due to the timing of many operational aspects in both revenue and expenditures that only occur annually or quarterly. We will continue to track both levels through the fiscal year to assist with fiscally responsible operational decisions.

In the graph above, expenditures have been higher than revenue from August until the current month. Revenue is higher in February compared to the prior month, but receipts are not expected to continue this trend throughout the remainder of this fiscal year. Real property tax collections generally cause the highest peaks in revenue during the year.

A long-time priority of the Treasurer's department is to utilize the collaboration method for resource allocation while taking a proactive approach with a commitment to supporting a learning environment that ensures an equitable and effective education.
