# PAY ATTENTION TO PREREQUISITES AND GRADE LEVEL . . .

#### Writing for Publication

This course is designed to acquaint students with the basic techniques of writing including but not limited to newspaper writing, literary writing, personal essay writing, podcasting and more. Students will practice interviewing, researching, organizing, editing, and developing final copy and headlines. Emphasis will be placed on professional attitude and behavior as well as perfecting journalistic skills. All students be responsible for writing, and writing is a major portion of the students' assessment. (ENG4)

Length of Course: Semester 1 or Semester 2

Grade Level: 9, 10, 11, 12 Prerequisite: None GR: English Elective NCAA approved

#### Yearbook

Students will be involved in every step of creating the WBHS yearbook. This includes copywriting, creative writing, editing copy or layout and graphics design, ad sales, marketing, photography, supply contains a supply by application in December and may be




