Non-resident students of Putnam County are subject to an additional \$25.00 fee per course. Summer school fees are not subject to standard fee waivers.

Timeline

The online course will be accessible from **Thursday, May 30, 2024 until Sunday, June 30, 2024**. All course requirements **must** be finished by midnight on **June 30, 2024**. There will be **NO extensions**.

Orientation/Summer School Rules

All **students and at least 1 parent/guardian** will be **required** to attend one virtual orientation session. Both student and parent will receive orientation session link through the emails provided. During the orientation session, students and parents/guardians will learn how to navigate the course software system, expectations of the program, timeline of events, teacher contact information and course requirements. Students are expected to honor and comply with the following summer school rules. Violation of these rules could result in immediate expulsion from summer school. No refunds will be granted to students expelled for violation of these rules.

Remedial Course Work & Credit

Coursework is provided by Apex online. These courses are aligned to the Ohio's Learning Standards. After the course end-date, each school will receive an individual report showing the student's progress and time spent working on coursework. It will be the local school's decision whether or not the student receives credit based on the data reports.
